In the Gospel of John we hear the story of how Jesus, in the final hours before his death, taught his followers some essential truths. This is part of what he taught them: "This is my commandment, that you love one another as I have loved you. No one has greater love than this, to lay down one's life for one's friends."

On this Sunday before Memorial Day, we pause to remember the self-giving love of Jesus Christ that he modeled for us and which has been imitated in the self-giving love of those men and women who died in military service to our country:

- · we remembered and we prayed for our soldiers who laid down their lives for their friends and fellow citizens;
- we remembered and we prayed for those who put the health and well-being of others above their own;
- we remembered and we prayed for those who did not lay down their lives, but who suffered physical, emotional, or mental damage and need healing;

- we remembered and we prayed for those soldiers and military family members who need our ongoing support and care;
- we remembered and we prayed for our leaders to honor our soldiers, and all of us, by leading with wisdom and restraint;
- we remembered and we prayed for the example of Jesus Christ to be the vision of service for all of us, whoever we are and wherever we are;
- we long for and we prayed for a world filled with peace, where we no longer need to lay down our lives for our friends anymore.

Donations of Required Minimum Distributions from Retirement Accounts

Did you know that you can make a donation of all or a portion of the Required Minimum Distribution from your retirement account to tax exempt charities, such as Lower Brandywine Presbyterian Church and your donation will be tax exempt?

Here's how it works. If a person is at least age 70½, they must take at least a minimum distribution from their IRA or incur a penalty equal to one-half of the otherwise required minimum distribution amount. They may take more than the minimum at their discretion. These individuals may instruct their IRA account manager to distribute any amount of their choosing to one or more tax exempt charities such as Lower Brandywine Presbyterian.

When that is done, it is considered to be a tax-exempt contribution. Lower Brandywine would acknowledge to the giver the receipt of that contribution from their IRA. Also, this contribution is tax exempt even if the individual does not itemize deductions for income tax purposes because the IRA account manager would not identify this to the IRS as reportable income in accordance with the tax code.
