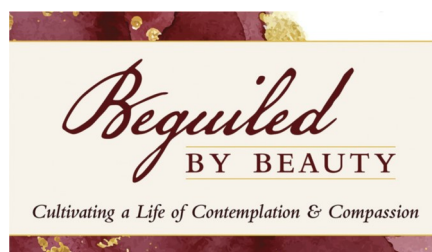

## Pastor's Ponderings

Friends, this week begins our summer worship series, *Beguiled by Beauty: Cultivating a Life of Contemplation and Compassion*, a worship series based on a resource from Dr. Marcia McFee's Worship Design Studio.

The Worship Design Studio website describes this worship series in this way,

"An early 6<sup>th</sup> century theologian described God as 'beguiled by beauty'. The Creator was lured by a longing for beauty and so set in motion a world of immense diversity and goodness. We were made for this Divine Goodness. We were made inherently worth, not by our "doing" but by our simply being. All things are beautiful- both by a standard of pretty as seen by our eyes but by an essence of sacred worth that is sense by the spirit. This is the root and heart of compassion and justice. Practices of contemplation help us train our gaze to these deeper truths. In this worship series we will dwell with the God of Divine Goodness, deeply in love with us, and practice was to return that love as we fall more deeply in love with creation and with one another. "

During this series, we will be spending intentional time exploring together what it means to live a life that is focused on the compassion to which God's loves calls us. We will learn about and experience together different spiritual practices intended to help us cultivate a new habit. For some of us, this might be a time filled with learning, when we are stretched spiritually. Others may have already integrated these practices into your spiritual life. Our prayer for all is that this series be a meaningful time of exploring God's word and thinking about practical ways in which we can deepen our spiritual lives. Whether you are a veteran of regular spiritual practice, or whether this is your first time employing these different methods of listening and speaking to God, we trust it will be a meaningful time of contemplating compassion. I hope that you will be able to join in either in person or online on Sunday mornings!

When that is done, it is considered to be a tax-exempt contribution. Lower Brandywine would acknowledge to the giver the receipt of that contribution from their IRA. Also, this contribution is tax exempt even if the individual does not itemize deductions for income tax purposes because the IRA account manager would not identify this to the IRS as reportable income in accordance with the tax code.
