"...Many of you know that she (Shirley) has been under hospice care since late Spring once it was determined that there was nothing curative the Doctors could do for her medically. Since then, my brother and my objective are to keep her as happy, comfortable, and pain-free as possible. The depth of compassionate caring extended to her through The Hickman and Compassus is incomparable.

Jeff and I are in constant communication with hospice, and it appears that Mom is accelerating into the final stages of her life. She is still conscious, a pip basically - equal parts mischievous and endearing to those around her. She is still eating - very little, but the weakness in her poor heart can no longer circulate her system, and the feeling is her time is at hand. Jeff and I have made arrangements to be east together for the coming weeks.

My reason for writing is that communicating with her is difficult and strained - something I know too well as I depend on Facetime daily to check in with her. Jeff and I are committed to sharing narratives and relaying the impact she has had on our lives and others. If you have a story to share or a message, please feel free to email me. We will make sure she hears it. As many of you know, hearing is the last sense that leaves us, and we would like her to know her value right up until she departs this world.

And please feel free to extend this offer to anyone who considers her a friend. Visits are difficult and tiring. She is awake only in small batches. But, Jeff and I will make sure that when she is awake, she hears all 'the good stuff.'"

Donations of Required Minimum Distributions from Retirement Accounts

Did you know that you can make a donation of all or a portion of the Required Minimum Distribution from your retirement account to tax exempt charities, such as Lower Brandywine Presbyterian Church and your donation will be tax exempt?

Here's how it works. If a person is at least age 70½, they must take at least a minimum distribution from their IRA or incur a penalty equal to one-half of the otherwise required minimum distribution amount. They may take more than the minimum at their discretion. These individuals may instruct their IRA account manager to distribute any amount of their choosing to one or more tax exempt charities such as Lower Brandywine Presbyterian.

When that is done, it is considered to be a tax-exempt contribution. Lower Brandywine would acknowledge to the giver the receipt of that contribution from their IRA. Also, this contribution is tax exempt even if the individual does not itemize deductions for income tax purposes because the IRA account manager would not identify this to the IRS as reportable income in accordance with the tax code.
