Pastor's Ponderings

The Rev. Emma Horn

"Be A Witness To These Things"

Many times, when we meet someone new, we talk about the answers to two questions, "Who are you?" and "What do you do?" When we learn these answers, they help us to know a little about the other person's identity and help us to learn about how they interact with the world around them. While these questions don't reveal everything about someone's identity, they are at least a start.

After Jesus crucifixion and resurrection, the disciples found themselves asking these same questions, "Who are we?" and "What do we do?" In this week's scripture, Jesus answers these questions of both who the disciples are and what they are to do, saying in Luke 24:48 "You are witnesses of these things." This statement from Jesus is not just a call to action but, a statement about the identity of believers-that at our deepest core we are witnesses of these things. This idea of being a witness is not just an action that we take but who we are. Professor Karoline Lewis, writing on the website Working Preacher, describes the passage in this way, "Jesus' address to the disciples is not 'you will be witnesses'. Not 'please be witnesses.' Not 'consider being witnesses if you have time.' No, 'you are witnesses of these things.' We are witnesses." As a community of faith we get to explore together what it means to more fully live into this identity of being witnesses. I hope that you will join in worship this Sunday, either in person or via our live stream as we wrestle and explore Luke 24:36-48 together, and learn more about what it meant for the early disciples and what it means for us today.

Donations of Required Minimum Distributions from Retirement Accounts

Did you know that you can make a donation of all or a portion of the Required Minimum Distribution from your retirement account to tax exempt charities, such as Lower Brandywine Presbyterian Church and your donation will be tax exempt?

Here's how it works. If a person is at least age 70½, they must take at least a minimum distribution from their IRA or incur a penalty equal to one-half of the otherwise required minimum distribution amount. They may take more than the minimum at their discretion. These individuals may instruct their IRA account manager to distribute any amount of their choosing to one or more tax exempt charities such as Lower Brandywine Presbyterian.

When that is done, it is considered to be a tax-exempt contribution. Lower Brandywine would acknowledge to the giver the receipt of that contribution from their IRA. Also, this contribution is tax exempt even if the individual does not itemize deductions for income tax purposes because the IRA account manager would not identify this to the IRS as reportable income in accordance with the tax code.
