
The Joy of Christmas draws nearer each week as we journey through Advent. And this Sunday, we light the pink candle of Joy in worship.

Finding joy in these days is complicated. We're so aware of the injustice and suffering around us that to be joyful can feel insensitive. And frankly, this season can be hard for it makes fresh our grief as we journey in isolation or without those we've lost. And joy isn't a word we use with any frequency. We're happy or we're fine. But joyful?

This week in preparation for Gaudete/Joy Sunday, I encourage you to take a few minutes each day to consider the source of your *joy*. How is the birth of the Christ Child a source of joy for you? In this season, despite all the reasons not to be joyful, where do you find yourself lighter, eager, hopeful, deeply contented?

Perhaps, this description of Joy will help as you pause: Joy is caused by elation at a moment in time. Joy may not always be about oneself but be about others' contentment also. Happiness is about the self's pleasure. Happiness may dwell on materialistic, worldly pleasure while joy is derived from soul satisfying, emotional well-being.

#### **Donations of Required Minimum Distributions from Retirement Accounts**

Did you know that you can make a donation of all or a portion of the Required Minimum Distribution from your retirement account to tax exempt charities, such as Lower Brandywine Presbyterian Church and your donation will be tax exempt?

Here's how it works. If a person is at least age 70½, they must take at least a minimum distribution from their IRA or incur a penalty equal to one-half of the otherwise required minimum distribution amount. They may take more than the minimum at their discretion. These individuals may instruct their IRA account manager to distribute any amount of their choosing to one or more tax exempt charities such as Lower Brandywine Presbyterian.

When that is done, it is considered to be a tax-exempt contribution. Lower Brandywine would acknowledge to the giver the receipt of that contribution from their IRA. Also, this contribution is tax exempt even if the individual does not itemize deductions for income tax purposes because the IRA account manager would not identify this to the IRS as reportable income in accordance with the tax code.

For more information about Qualified Charitable Distributions, check out the Internal Revenue Service Publication 590-B, "Distributions from Individual Retirement Arrangements (IRAs)" or speak with your tax advisor.
