This past week, January 6th, was Epiphany. The day we recall the journey of the magi, or wise men, as they followed the star which led them to the child, Jesus.

At worship on Sunday, folks received an Epiphany Star. Each star printed with a single word which becomes your word when you receive it. It becomes your word to receive. A gift, chosen for you by the Spirit.

The word on each star is an invitation to follow where it leads you, seeking to draw nearer to Jesus. It provides an intentional way to seek Jesus in your daily life. Perhaps seeing it on your mirror each morning invites you to spend a few moments wondering how that word speaks to you and your life this day. Maybe having it tucked into the Bible marking the place for your daily reading prompts you to hear the word of God in light of that star word, drawing out new meanings for you. Or it could find its place on your dashboard, where your time in the car becomes a holy place to ponder just what God may be saying to you through that one particular word.

Donations of Required Minimum Distributions from Retirement Accounts

Did you know that you can make a donation of all or a portion of the Required Minimum Distribution from your retirement account to tax exempt charities, such as Lower Brandywine Presbyterian Church and your donation will be tax exempt?

Here's how it works. If a person is at least age 70%, they must take at least a minimum distribution from their IRA or incur a penalty equal to one-half of the otherwise required minimum distribution amount. They may take more than the minimum at their discretion. These individuals may instruct their IRA account manager to distribute any amount of their choosing to one or more tax exempt charities such as Lower Brandywine Presbyterian.

When that is done, it is considered to be a tax-exempt contribution. Lower Brandywine would acknowledge to the giver the receipt of that contribution from their IRA. Also, this contribution is tax exempt even if the individual does not itemize deductions for income tax purposes because the IRA account manager would not identify this to the IRS as reportable income in accordance with the tax code.

For more information about Qualified Charitable Distributions, check out the Internal Revenue Service Publication 590-B, "Distributions from Individual Retirement Arrangements (IRAs)" or speak with your tax advisor.
