The following Codes of Conduct are in addition to the DBA and MCYFL Bylaws.

Player Code of Conduct

As a Denville Blue Angels player I agree to the following code of conduct.

1. I will treat my teammates, coaches, officials, opponents, and spectators with good sportsmanship and respect.
2. I will attend and participate in all team events unless I have an excused absence.
3. I will compete with the highest level of sportsmanship, understanding that I represent my family, my team, and the DBA program - both during and away from DBA events.
4. I will remember that I am a student first, and that sports are a privilege.
5. I will come prepared with all required equipment for practices and games.
6. I will advocate for myself and talk to my coaches if I have any questions or concerns about my role on the team.
7. I will respect my equipment and return it to the DBA program at the end of the season in the same condition that they were issued to me.



Parent Code of Conduct

As a Denville Blue Angels parent I agree to the following code of conduct.

1. I will treat players, coaches, officials, opponents, and spectators with good sportsmanship and respect.
2. I will cheer positively from the stands.
3. I will not yell at players, coaches, or officials for any reason.
4. I will let the coaches coach the team, and I will not coach from the stands.
5. I will not permit my non-player guests to enter the playing area at any time, including siblings of players.
6. I will address any questions or concerns to the coaching staff at the appropriate time.
7. If I feel my questions or concerns were not addressed to my satisfaction, I will contact the President and Player Agent of Denville Blue Angels.
8. I will drop-off and pick-up my player at the appropriate times.
9. I will observe all rules and guidelines posted at all fields.
10. I understand that my player and I are responsible for all equipment issued to us by DBA, and that we are required to return all equipment to the DBA program at the end of the year in the same condition it was issued to us. I also understand that DBA reserves the right to charge the responsible player/family for damaged or lost equipment at the cost to replace the equipment.
