






The promise is that AI can do many tasks just as well as a human which frees up humans to either work harder or do whatever they want.




Al wins Chess (1997)

- Significant milestone and demonstrates power of machine learning




Al wins Go (2017)

How quickly will AI disrupt our lives and livelihood?




AI classifying cats... then AI tutors... next stop killer robots??






- The technologies that enable AI to progress are more available, abundant and cheaper than ever.

Communication is more than words. Non-verbal cues and communication may be surprisingly important.








Machine vision and algorithms vs Human with access to the internet?


Don't look for chatbots to take your jobs yet...

Tutors need to keep working on human-only qualities to earn their right to educate




Teachers will not be replaced by technology, but teachers who do not use technology will be replaced by those who do." – Hari Krishna Arya, India
