Youngest child present, Walter Edward Wilcutts; Traveling longest distance, Gladys Ingolia; Most recent married couple, Mr. & Mrs. John F. Bowen. At this time we were favored by a solo by Gloria Rogers, "He", accompanied by Albert Cherrix.

The reunion will be held in 1960 in the Christian Church Social Room on the fourth Sunday. The Following officers were elected: President, Willie Leake; Secretary, Lillian Disharoon; Ass't. Secretary, Marie Bounds; Treasurer, Mary Figgs; Co-Historian's, Gladys Ingolia and Harvey Pusey. It was decided next year to serve the food Buffett Style. The following were named to set up the tables next year: Fred Cherrix, Preston Bounds, and Harvey Pusey. The treasurer was asked to pay for laundering the tablecloths and to give a donation to the Church. In closing we all sang "God Be With You". Rev. Caperoon pronounced the Benediction.
