Problem Statement:

- Veterans Suicide Rate: The escalating number of veterans every day who lose their fight and succumb to suicide
- Veterans Unemployment: High growing rate of unemployed veterans, especially among disabled veterans.
- Underutilized Skill Sets: Difficulty finding fulfilling jobs.
- Drone Industry Opportunity: Lucrative careers, but lack of training and resources.
- Bridging the Gap: The divide between civilians and veterans is real and makes it difficult to relate to the challenges that our veterans face when they transition home



Proof of Concept

The Veterans Drone Training Program's first class launched on April 6, 2024, with 12 veterans enrolled. Funded by a U.S. Senate grant and partnered with ACEA (Atlantic County Economic Alliance), ACCC (Atlantic Cape Community College), and 22Zero Organization.

The current 'first' class of 12 veterans are being trained in a comprehensive drone training curriculum, which includes the following:

- Comprehensive drone training
- Hands-on flight training
- Exam preparation
- Job placement assistance
- Mental health resources.

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
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Why A Write to Heal


