Why run this race?

Gulliver was my running companion for nine years. But even more important than that, he was my friend! He was "Just a dog", some may say. Well yes, he was a dog, but those of you who share your lives with a dog will understand my feelings.

Gulliver was a Hungarian Vizsla, a breed known for energy, intelligence, and loyalty. He certainly had energy! I started to take him running with me and I only tended to slow him down. So another Vizsla, Duncan, joined our family to help share in the task of expending energy during the runs. Thus, Team Vizsla was established.

In October 2011, shortly after Gulliver's 8th birthday, the unthinkable happened. Gulliver was diagnosed with canine lymphoma. After the initial shock, we found a clinical trial for Gulliver. We resolved to keep Gulliver with us for as long as the treatments did not compromise his quality of life. And for 13 blessed months Gulliver kept on running! He never complained, was rarely uncomfortable, and always wanted to go for our daily runs. We slowed down a bit, but we kept on running! Gulliver participated in 15 races in the last 13 months of his life, without any discomfort or struggle. He set the pace, and we enjoyed every second of our time together! Gulliver kept on running right up until 2 days before he passed away, which happened in our (his) home peacefully.

In 2024, one week before Gulliver's Run, Maisy, our beautiful Vizsla, was diagnosed with stage 4 canine cancer. Maisy joined our family one week after we lost Gulliver in 2012. She was a very special dog and was loved by all her knew her. Maisy was part of every Gulliver's Run for 12 years.

Maisy's March is a 3.5K loop that Maisy traveled the last morning of her life before losing her battle against canine bladder cancer. May her gentle Vizsla spirit help and guide us all in this fight.

We are determined to continue Gulliver's race against canine cancer. "Gulliver's Run" is being held to raise funds for the research necessary to combat this terrible disease. "Gulliver's Run" is a trail run/walk for canine-human teams which is in Gifford Pinchot State Park, where Gulliver and Team Vizsla spent endless time together. The goal of this "race" is to enjoy that bond and to raise funds to fight canine cancer.

Please join us! Please be generous! We have pledged all proceeds to be used for the fight against canine cancer. Our partnership with an established canine cancer research/ treatment organization enables our donations to go directly towards work that targets various types of canine cancer. Come out for a day of fun and challenges! Gulliver's Run gives us all a chance to fight back. Let's cross the finish line together!

The goal of this event is to have fun while raising money to fight canine cancer

This course is on the trails of Pinchot Park. You will encounter rocks, roots, uneven footing, and other features of running on a forest trail. There are some hills of moderate elevation. The width of the trail varies. There could be mud or wet/soggy areas of the trail, depending on the weather. Early November in Pennsylvania can be pleasant, or not. Please put your dog's welfare first! Please do not enter your dog if the distance is beyond your routine training run. Additional notes regarding your participation with your canine friend will be covered in the waiver. All dogs need to be licensed and up to date with shots. Proof of rabies vaccination is required upon request. Dogs need to be leashed and under control at all times. All sociable dogs are welcome. The race director/race staff reserves the right to exclude any dog for behavior or health related concerns on race day. Please clean up after your dog. Plastic bags will be provided at registration/packet pick-up.
