- All fruit, produce and other articles for competition must be grown or made by the exhibitor. Any infringement means disqualification.
- The Show Hall will be open from **12.30** pm on the Friday 21st February to receive all exhibits.
- All junior exhibits must be in the Show Hall by 6.00pm on Friday 21st February . No Exceptions.

Judging will commence at 6.30pm on Friday Late entries will not be accepted.

No article will be staged for competition which has any label or mark by which the owner can be known to the judges.

- Any exhibit which is interfered with after being dealt with by the Stewards will be disqualified.
- The Association reserves the right to substitute vouchers in lieu of prize money.
- No exhibit is to be removed from the Show Hall before **3.30**pm on Show Day.
- All exhibits must be collected from the show hall by 5.00pm on Show Day.
- Any exhibitor having complaint with anything in connection with the Show should promptly give particulars to the Secretary in writing.
- Where there are less than 3 entries in a class, there may be only 1 prize awarded, at the judges discretion.
- All junior 1st prizes are \$3.00 and 2nd prizes are \$1.00 unless sponsored.
- The Society reserves the right to amend the schedule of prizes where a sponsor withdraws or fails to meet a commitment.
- All entries should not have been shown at the Exeter Show previously.

INSTRUCTIONS TO THE JUDGES

- The judges are requested to give their awards in accordance with true commercial value of each exhibit in the produce sections and where necessary to cut and taste.
