Whenever replacement parts or labor charges not covered by this agreement are required, Ryder Air Conditioning shall notify the customer of the estimated additional charges.

The obligation to furnish repair and/or replacement parts is subject to the availability of such parts from normal sources of supply.

Ryder Air Conditioning shall not be liable for loss, damage or injury arising from its performance of service, unless solely caused by its negligence.

If this agreement is cancelled, customer agrees to pay for all services and materials rendered to date of cancellation.

Automatic renewal: This agreement will be automatically renewed. You will be billed according to the billing procedure stated above. If you do not wish to continue this service you must cancel this agreement prior to the start of the next seasonal maintenance.

Since this agreement is for preventive maintenance only and not repairs, there is no warranty on labor unless unit failure is due strictly to neglect on Ryder's part. The extent of neglect, versus the cost of repairs, shall be determined by Ryder Air Conditioning and adjustments shall be made accordingly.
