COVID-19 UPDATE

COVID-19 vaccines continue to work well to prevent severe illness and death. The vaccines are working against the Omicron variant. This form of the coronavirus spreads easier but has less severe illness than earlier forms. Data shows that booster shots and additional doses can help people stay fully protected:

• A booster shot can help you stay fully protected over time. Data shows that protection against milder illness lessens over time. This is especially true for certain groups of people. The CDC recommends that everyone who is at least 18 years old should get a booster shot. Teens ages 16 to 17 can also now get a booster shot. Learn about getting a booster shot

• Some people need an additional dose to get full protection. Certain groups of people may not have had a strong enough immune response from the first 2 doses. Learn about getting an additional dose.

Note: Not all VA health facilities have all types of vaccines right now. And facilities may offer different vaccines at different times. Confirm that the facility has the vaccine you want before you make your appointment.


FUNDRAISING
