

Is Your Ministry Effective?

“God answered, “I will be with you. And this is your sign that I am the one who has sent you: When you have brought the people out of Egypt, you will worship God at this very mountain.” (Exodus 3:12 NLT)

Sometimes, we might wonder if we have a ministry, and if we do have a ministry, we might wonder if we are effective in that ministry. I’m learning to understand that when you’re walking in your purpose, you’re going to be effective in what you’re called to do.

When Moses asked the Lord “How will I know you sent me?” The Lord’s response in the scripture above was basically letting Moses know that when you see that you

have actually accomplished that thing that I sent you out to do; this in itself is a sign that you are effective in your calling. The second sign is when the glory is returned unto the Lord, in other words, when you are an “answered” prayer, so to speak you are being effective in your ministry.

The Israelites had been crying out to God, the Bible says “for reason of the bondage”, and the Lord heard their cry. In response to their situation, the Lord sent Moses to deliver them. It was because Moses was an “answered” prayer, that they were to worship God for their deliverance.

While operating in your ministry have you ever had your ministry confirmed through others? Have people come to you and said “You are an answered prayer”, have people ever come to you and said “Wow, that’s a confirmation!”. These are all confirming your ministry and that you are being effective in the calling in which you are operating. So keep up the good work!
