Dear Parent(s):

As our Family Handbook states, a family's demonstrated support of and commitment to Waldorf education and our school are important factors in enrollment decisions. Our criteria includes consideration of our school's ability to meet the needs of the prospective student, whether the student is an appropriate fit for the existing class, whether the family can act in a productive partnership with our faculty, and whether the enrollment is in the best interests of the school as a whole. For these reasons, each family and child is subject to review for each progressive school year based on these criteria, their commitment to our school, and its guiding principles.

Further, under the express terms of your Tuition and Enrollment Agreement and the Family Handbook "the Waldorf School of Tampa Bay retains the right to terminate the enrollment of any student, at any time and for any reason, if the enrollment is determined in the school's sole discretion to be contrary to the best interests of the school."

We have conducted a review and have determined that the continued enrollment of your family is not in the best interests of the Waldorf School of Tampa Bay. In undertaking this review, we have considered the totality of the circumstances relevant to your family's enrollment in the school, including your conduct as parents in the context of our Code of Conduct regarding [Communication in the Adult Community](#). Accordingly, your family's enrollment at the WSTB is discontinued effective immediately. If you would like to discuss this decision in a direct meeting, please contact me to schedule by 3pm June 26, 2023.

We realize that this outcome is not what either the school or your family intended when you enrolled, and we wish you all the best in finding a different educational path for your family. We will prepare your Involuntary Withdrawal Settlement which will be emailed within 14 business days.
