	OPTION 1: Junior High Bareback & Saddle Bronc Riding Events will be offered for each approved qualifying, practice and/or state/province or district rodeo. They may be held in conjunction with the rodeo or held at a different time and location for each rodeo. They must be offered the same number of times as all the other events, such as pole bending, bull riding, etc. If OPTION 1 is used, all points carned throughout the year and at the state/provincial finals will be applied toward the All-Around. OPTION 2: Junior High Bareback & Saddle Bronc Riding Events must be offered a minimum three (3) times within each district and/or state/province and their finals. Only the points earned at the finals will count toward the All-Around. Points earned at the qualifying events and the state/provincial finals will be used for the year end Champions.
