Junior High Bareback & Saddle Bronc Riding Events are events of the National High School Rodeo Association and must be offered in the state, district, province programs including their finals. Holding these two events is not an option in each program; however, the manner in which the All-Around points are counted is an option. Either option will allow the state/province to qualify a full team of Junior High Bareback & Saddle Bronc Riding contestants to the NJHFR.

For the 2026-2027 National High School Rodeo Association year, our state/province has elected to handle the Junior High Bareback & Saddle Bronc Riding events in the following manner:

_____ OPTION 1: Junior High Bareback & Saddle Bronc Riding Events will be offered for each approved qualifying, practice and/or state/province or district rodeo. They may be held in conjunction with the rodeo or held at a different time and location for each rodeo. They must be offered the same number of times as all the other events, such as pole bending, bull riding, etc. If OPTION 1 is used, all points earned throughout the year and at the state/provincial finals will be applied toward the All-Around.

_____ OPTION 2: Junior High Bareback & Saddle Bronc Riding Events must be offered a minimum three (3) times within each district and/or state/province and their finals. Only the points earned at the finals will count toward the All-Around. Points earned at the qualifying events and the state/provincial finals will be used for the year end Champions.
