# **OHSRA Cutting & Reined Cow Horse(RCH) Events**

- 1. Events must be OHSRA / NCHA(cutting) or ARHA(RCH) approved
- 2. OHSRA Member must enter the CUTTING or RCH event on the OHSRA entry from (google form)
- 3. Member then attends the sanctioned event and enters the YOUTH class (youth cutting or youth working cow horse).
- 4. After competition An OHSRA representative must obtain & submit a copy of official judges' card to the OHSRA secretary within 5 days.
- 5. Member is required to compete wearing their back number

### **Points**

- Regular Season Cutting Points: 10pts for 1st, 9pts for 2nd, 8pts for 3rd, etc.
- > State Finals Round Points: 20pts for 1st, 18pts for 2nd, 16pts, for 3rd, etc.
- State Finals Average Points: 30pts for 1st, 27pts for 2nd, 24pts for 3rd, etc.
- > Boys & Girls cutting are separate events (and pointed separately)
- > Boys & Girls RCH are one event (and not pointed separately)
- > Placings and points are given to OHSRA members only
- > Year-end Champion is determined by the member with the highest total points
- > Only the points from the State Finals count toward the All-around
- > Top 4 in each event at year-end qualify for the National High School Finals

Upon arrival at the event, ENTER THE YOUTH CLASS through the show secretary, wear your back number.
