

Vote for anti-apartheid congressional candidates or choose neither.

We believe in starting from the top to elect new leaders that will end U.S. support for apartheid and genocide.

Vote No Evil encourages protesting the lack of representation in congress by withholding your vote from congressional races with no anti-apartheid candidates.

In the United States a ballot cannot legally be canceled or disqualified as the result of an undervote. All other selections will be tabulated and counted. We encourage full participation in all other races.

To choose neither is to register a vote of no confidence in our current U.S. Congress.

Improved voting technology enables municipalities to extract and distribute raw ballot-level data produced during the tabulation process. By intentionally undervoting to protest lack of choice we'll make our numbers visible in unambiguous terms.

Our votes and your participation in this action will remain anonymous.

And your voice will be counted among the many who oppose apartheid and genocide via public records requests.

As our movement and electoral power grows we will push to replace all members of congress who fail to represent the will of the people. We've seen many candidates disqualified and ballot access blocked, but we're not giving up. We're putting congress on notice.
