## About The NRHS

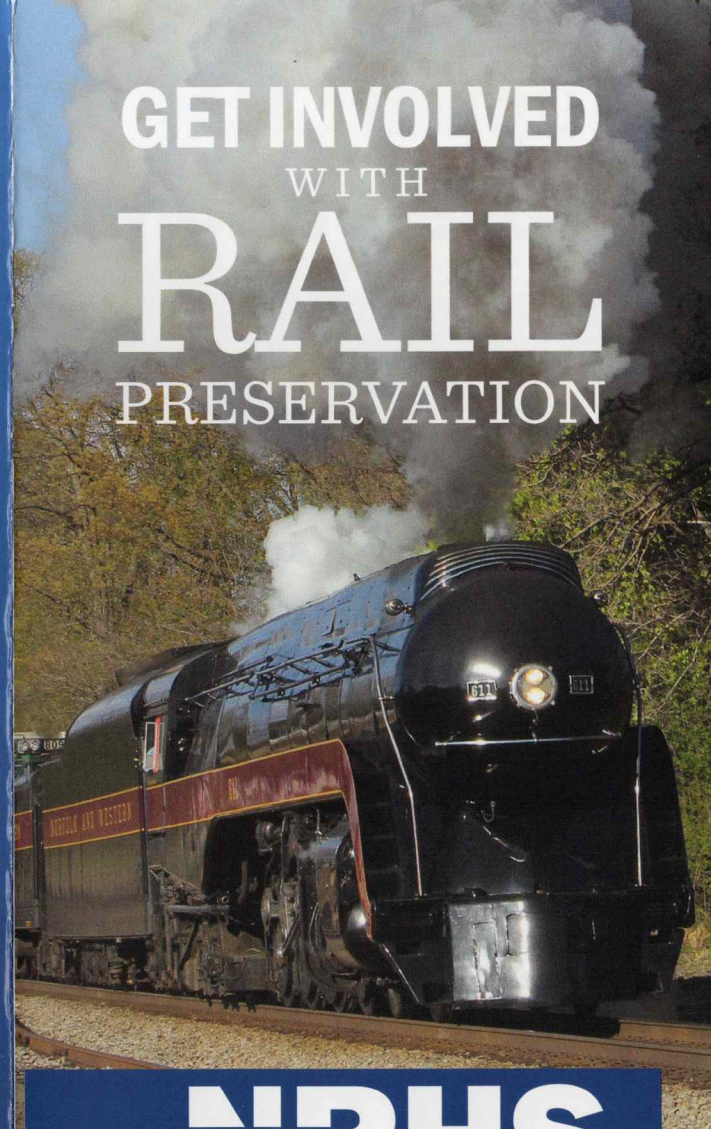
National Railway Historical Society

An annual event allowing our membership to experience a variety of railroad excursions and related programs.

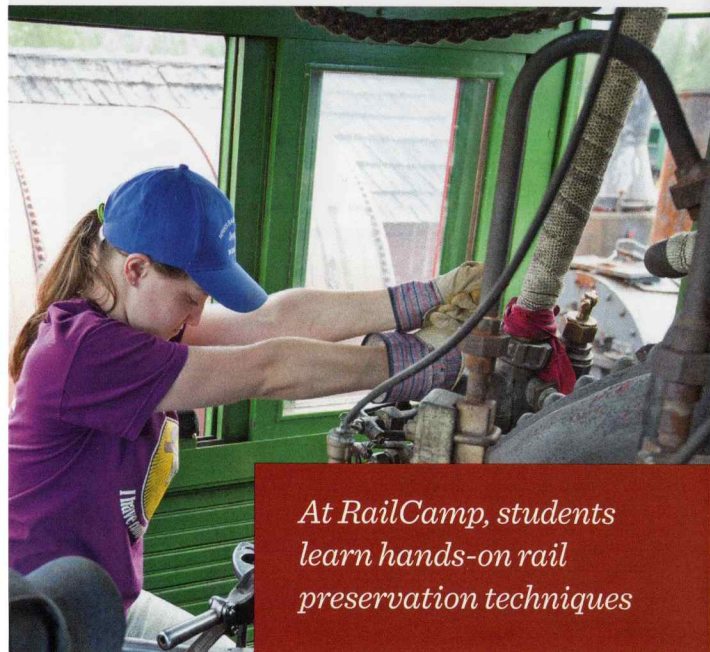
## DISCOUNT PROGRAMS

## HERITAGE GRANTS

The NRHS Heritage Grants program provides financial support to projects that contribute to the preservation of, and education about, railway history. Since 1991, NRHS has provided over \$1,250,000 to rail preservation efforts, through hundreds of grants to non-profit organizations.

- Four annual issues of the NRHS Bulletin, a glossy magazine rich with long-form features about railroading and rail history
- Six online and up to three printed issues annually of the NRHS News, packed with stories related to chapter activities, NRHS events, and railroad history and preservation.
- The chance to experience railroad attractions, interact with like-minded rail historians, and to renew old friendships at our annual convention.
- An organized, safe, international social network of railroad enthusiasts, preservationists and students of railroad history
- Opportunities to contribute to local projects or national efforts that protect, educate, preserve, and promote railroading
- Access to members-only online webinar programs featuring interviews with authors and historians, discussions with people performing historic restorations, and video programs featuring historic and current-day subjects.
