

DAY 1- ARRIVE ISLAMABAD

Upon arrival at Islamabad airport, you will be greeted by Xperience Pakistan's ground representative and transferred to the hotel.

After some rest we will start with a Dhaba Lunch and spend the afternoon sightseeing around Islamabad. Key sites we will take you are Faisal Mosque, Lok Virsa museum & Pakistan monument.

We will end the day by having dinner at Monal, a restaurant, which provides you with a great panoramic view of Islamabad and is a popular place for families to congregate at on the weekend.

DAY 2- RAWALPINDI

Early morning food tour of Rawalpindi to enjoy the best Nihari (a slow- cooked meal made up of lamb / beef shanks eaten for breakfast), followed by a live demo on how to make Lassi, a traditional yoghurt based drink, which can be made sweet or salty.

We will also take you on a trip to spice Bazaar and fruit market to introduce you to the basic spices used in Pakistani Cuisine.

DAY 3- RAWALPINDI - SWAT

Soak in the scenic drive to Swat. Stop over for lunch to enjoy freshly caught fish from Swat River right beside the river, enjoy the fresh tandoor naan and some lentils.

DAY 5 DRIVE TO PESHAWAR PM

Qissa Khwani means to story tell and in earlier days it was the hub where tradesmen would stopover in the evenings to get some rest and exchange tales of their business and travel adventures. You will find many green tea hubs, where you can sit and enjoy some traditional Kawa chai.

In the evening you will be able to sit down dinner at a restaurant in Qissa Khwani and enjoy the evening ambience.

DAY 7 PESHAWAR - ISLAMABAD

Islamabad - Lahore G.T road stop over for a scrumptious lunch at a driver hotel. Evening trip the Badshahi Mosque and a Lahore food street sampling dinner.

DAY 8 LAHORE

Start the morning at 9am to visit Lahore museum followed by Liberty market trip for shopping & grab some snacks.

Return to the hotel to freshen up.

Visit the Shalimar and Wagha Border, which will take place at 4.30 - 5pm. The experience at Wagha Border lasts around 2 hours, after this we will head back towards the centre of Lahore and take you to experience the modern side of the city of Lahore.

Evening meal at 'The Poet', which is food theatre at its best, if this is still closed for renovation we will take you to Dan Dan - 'A Chinese Hot Pot', a very popular eatery amongst the locals.

DAY 9 LAHORE

In the morning we will take you to enjoy a traditional Lahori breakfast –Pathorai- channai and halwas, followed by a Photo walk of the walled city tour.

The afternoon will be free for shopping at the local markets.

Late Lunch at 'Go Flour' Cafe, which is all about empowering women, changing their lives one loaf at a time.

In the evening we will take you for a late dinner at the 'Havelli' on food street, an authentic way to end the trip, overlooking the Badhshahi mosque with live music or option to go to 'Dynasty', a Chinese restaurant. Chinese in Pakistan is very different to the flavours experienced in the West.

DAY 10 LAHORE - HARRAPA - MULTAN

Enjoy evening street food. Overnight stay at Faletti's Multan



DAY 11 - MULTAN

Multan (Madinat-ul-Auliya) is known as the City of Saints, largely due to the abundant number of Sufi shrines that lie scattered across the city. In the morning you will visit some monuments like shrines of Shah Rukn-i-Alam, Bhahuddin Zikria and Shams Tabraz etc. Here we will also visit one of the workshops making the world renowned Multani Blue Tile. From Multan the journey takes you on to the capital of the Punjab next, as you drive to Lahore. Time permitting, stop en route at the famous archaeological site at Harappa, to discover the remains of a Bronze Age fortified city whose origins have been dated back to 2600 BC.

DAY 12 - MULTAN - KARACHI

Today we will explore upper Hunza & take you to the famous Attabad Lake created from a natural disaster, over here you can enjoy a small stint on a jet ski or on a boat.

In the afternoon we will take you to Moksha cafe, a cafe run by Faiz and Saira a couple committed to help support and educate the youth to becoming active and refined citizens of the community. They run a cafe, popular amongst the locals. They grow their own vegetables.

Saira will give you a live demo of one of the local popular cuisines, you can then enjoy a feast sitting in the traditional manner on the ground or at a table.

DAY 14 - KARACHI

After enjoying a typical Karachi breakfast we will take you to the Spices bazar in the evening followed by a live demo on seafood cooking.

DAY 15 - KARACHI

After breakfast, proceed for a city tour of Karachi, including Karachi Museum, which contains an important collection of items relating to Pakistan's Cultural heritage. Some other galleries display Indus Civilization artifacts, Gandhara Civilization Sculptures, Islamic Art, Miniature Paintings, Ancient Coins and Manuscripts documenting Pakistan's Political History. There is also an interesting Ethnological Gallery with life size statues of different ethnicities living in the four provinces of Pakistan. Then visit Mausoleum of Muhammad Ali Jinnah, one of the most impressive landmarks in Karachi which refers to the tomb of the founder of Pakistan, This monument is situated at the heart of the city which was completed in 1960s. Continue on to visit the Shrine of Abdullah Shah Ghazi. Born in Medina in 720 AD and widely revered throughout Pakistan, he is considered the patron saint of Karachi. In the late afternoon, we will go on a "crab fishing" tour on a local fishing vessel. We set sail from the Kemari port in a traditional, decorated fishing boat and enjoy the crisp sea breeze as you sail away from the buzz of the city. Once you leave the congestion of the port and enter clear waters, the gentle, lapping waves with the soft music on deck is enchanting. The captain drops anchor after about 45 minutes or so in order for the crew to prepare your food. It's a treat to watch the crew dextrously cook the freshly caught crabs live and serve them within minutes. You will enjoy a piping hot meal of crab masala, crab lollipops, crab cutlets, prawn masala, potato cutlets/french fries, tomato chutney, naan and parathas, along with chilled cold drinks and mineral water. While dining, you can enjoy the hubbub of the port from afar. Return to the port after enjoying 2 to 3 hours on the boat, and take the vehicle back to the hotel.

DAY 16 KARACHI

Departure from Karachi. Airport transfers will be arranged.

• Is Pakistan safe to travel to?

In the main Pakistan is a safe country to travel around, there are some random incidents but this is like anywhere in the world these days. On a day to day basis it is safe to get around especially key cities like Islamabad & Lahore. Like any country one must be vigilant, our team is always aware of the situation so if precautionary measures need to take place these are implemented.

• What do I need to wear?

You can wear western clothes as a woman or man. However it must be remembered that Pakistan is a muslim country so clothes should generally be loose, 3/4 arm length sleeves, skirts or dresses should be below the knees. Hair does not have to be covered except when entering places of worship. Shoes should also be taken off when entering a mosque. For the North it is best to dress with layers, for Islamabad & Peshawar their seasons follow the UK and temperatures do get cold Oct - March so warm attire is recommended.

• How much money do I need to take?

Eating out & shopping in the main in Pakistan is cheap, particularly at the moment when the currency is so weak. £3 will get you a 3 course meal at a very nice restaurant.

• What's the weather like?

The weather in Sindh, from Multan down to Karachi tends to be hot all year around. The best time to visit this region is Nov - Feb. The Northern areas of Pakistan get very cold with temperatures dropping below freezing. The best to visit this part is April - October. Islamabad, Lahore & Peshawar tend to have similar seasons to the UK, with the need of a coat or cardigan in the winters.

• What's the local currency?

The local currency is Pakistan Rupees, our guide will arrange to take you to a local Bureau De Exchange where you can exchange your currency and get the best rates. We will also help you get a local SIM which you can use throughout your trip to ensure you remain connected without paying exuberant international charges.

• Who can I get travel insurance with?

You can get insurance with Battle Face who cover countries which are off the beaten track.

NEXT STEPS

- Give us a call on 0203 150 1444 or email us on info@xperiencepakistan.co.uk if any of the tours are of interest to you or you would like a bespoke tour created for you.
- Deposit of 50% to be paid once happy with the itinerary or we can arrange an instalment plan of 3 payments, if time permits. Final payment would be due 8 weeks before your departure date.
- If interested in a group tour, we only require a £500 deposit to secure your place on the tour, if we are unable to get two people and the tour doesn't go ahead the full deposit is refunded minus any bank charges which would be applicable to international clients.
- The maximum group sizes are 8, if we are able to get 8 the price pp would reduce to that quoted which is based on 2 and the final balance owed would reflect this.
- We would provide you with all the documentation you would need for your visa application which is all done online now and takes 2-3 weeks to process. This would be provided after the 50% deposit payment.
- 3 weeks before your travel date we could create a whatsapp group made up of you, me and the team in Pakistan so that you can greet each other before your arrival in Pakistan. I would be contactable throughout your time in Pakistan, should a need arise for you to contact me, such as any changes in plan to due to ill health or change in interest once in the country. However rest assure that the team are very well versed to help you with all of these aspects.
- For group tours we would create a whatsapp group sooner and arrange a zoom call before your departure so you can meet and greet and compare notes.
