(6050M AND SHAPODIN PASS TREK)

EXPLORE LESS FREQUENTLY VISITED WILDERNESS TREK IN THE UPPER HUNZA VALLEY

Shimshal (3100m), a remote village nestled in the Himalayas, is a hidden gem of natural beauty, untouched by frequent visitors. Home to the Wakhi-speaking people, Shimshal is surrounded by majestic peaks like Lupghar Sar, Yazghail Sar, and Kanjut Sar, beloved by mountaineers. The village is also the starting point for treks to the famous Pamir Pass, Chafchingol Pass, and Lukpe La. Among these, Minglik Sar (6050m) is popular for being a relatively easy trekking peak, climbable in a day. On the way ack we will cross Shapodin Pass (5346m) to reach Shimshal village.

RAKAPOSHI BASE CAMP & RASH LAKE TREK

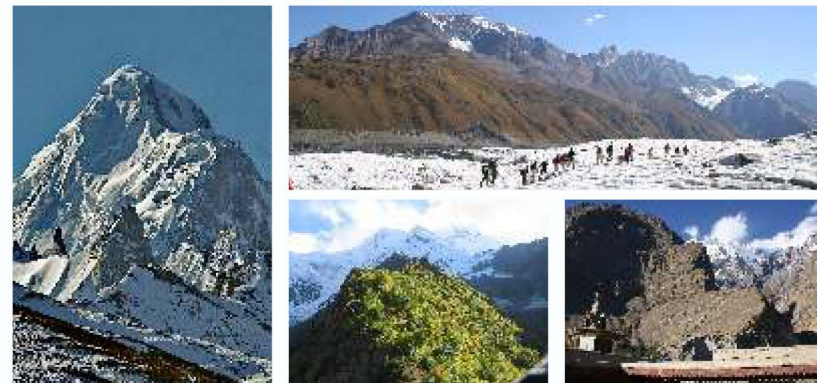
(3 TREKS IN ONE GO OR ANY SINGLE TREK CAN BE TAKEN)

THREE MESMERIZING TREKS IN THE MOUNTAIN KINGDOM

This trip combines three renowned treks in the Karakoram and Western Himalayas. First, embark on a moderate hike to the Raikot Face of Nanga Parbat via Fairy Meadows, where the iconic view of Nanga Parbat is a once-in-a-lifetime experience. The second part features a short trek from Minapin village to Rakaposhi Base Camp, offering a perfect introduction to Karakoram trekking. This trek provides stunning views of Rakaposhi, Diran, and the surrounding peaks, with a rewarding panorama from a ridge overlooking the North Batura. Finally, explore glaciers and villages, experiencing the daily life of those living near these mighty ice formations, and enjoy the scenic beauty of the Karakoram Mountains from the summit of Rush Peak (5098m).

THE HINDU KUSH TREK

(OVIR PASS & TIRICH MIR BASE CAMP)

CAPTIVATE YOURSELF IN THE STUNNING BEAUTY OF HINDU KUSH MOUNTAIN RANGE

Ovir Pass, the popular and easily accessible trek crosses a ridge-top pass along the southern flanks of mighty Tirich Mir, visiting friendly villages along the way. Crossing the Ovir Ann (4338m) is a short and popular trek that offers wonderful close-up views of the southern flanks of Tirich Mir massif. Afterwards we trek to Tirich Mir, the Hindu Kush's highest peak, rises above a vast wilderness of glaciers and 20 other impressive 7000 m summits, making this a trek into the very centre of the high Hindu Kush. Tirich Valley, a long, western branch of the Turikho Valley, leads towards the base of the highest Hindu Kush peaks; Noshag, Istori-o-Nal and Tirich Mir. The trek is combined with a cultural exploration of Kalash Valley (Kafiristan).

K-2 CLASSIC

(BALTORO K-2 BASE CAMP TREK)

PILGRIMAGE TO THE THRONE ROOM OF THE MOUNTAIN GODS

Ranked among the top ten classic hikes in the world, the Concordia K-2 Base Camp Trek is a wilderness adventure that every mountain lover should experience. Beginning in Islamabad and journeying through Skardu to the remote village of Askole, the trek offers breathtaking views of the Karakoram Mountains. Highlights include the stunning Baltoro Glacier, the dramatic rock spires of Urdukas, and the 360-degree panorama at Concordia, known as the "throne room of the mountain gods." Despite its challenges, this trek is accessible to those with good fitness, offering both natural beauty and cultural immersion with the warm hospitality of the Balti people.

IMMERSE YOURSELF IN THE WILDERNESS OF “THE KARAKORAM MOUNTAIN PLAYGROUND.”

If an adventure enthusiast, wishes to add value to his/her K-2 base camp trip, Gondogoro La 5450m is the most popular and frequently used high pass in the Karakoram. This route was established in 1986 that connects Concordia and the upper Baltoro Glacier to the beautiful Hushe Valley over the Gondogoro La. It's a quite challenging and technical pass but provides an alternate route to return from Concordia hence it is highly famous among trekkers and climbers. If weather favors, the high pass offers the most overwhelming and extraordinary view of K-2, Broad Peak, G-G-II, G-III, G-IV, Masherbrum and Chogolisa besides many other peaks and glaciers in the region.

EXPERIENCE THE ULTIMATE ADVENTURE VISITING FAIRY MEADOWS AND BALTORO GLACIER

The first part of this epic trek takes you to Fairy Meadows and the Nanga Parbat Base Camp via the Raikot Glacier. Nanga Parbat, standing at 8125m, is Pakistan's second-highest peak and one of the world's most challenging mountains. We'll explore the Raikot face, experiencing the stunning glaciers, local villages, and rich culture. Next, we head to Concordia, the “Throne Room of the Mountain Gods,” where we'll hike to the K2 and Gasherbrum base camps. Finally, we'll cross the Gondogoro La Pass at 5450m, offering breathtaking views of K2, Broad Peak, and many other towering peaks and glaciers in the Karakoram.

UNDERTAKE THE LONGEST GLACIER TRAVERSE OUT OF POLAR REGION

The Biafo and Hispar Glaciers are among the longest glaciers outside the polar regions, offering an epic trek that connects Baltistan to the legendary Hunza Valley. Our journey begins in Askole, where we hike across the Biafo Glacier, eventually reaching the expansive Snow Lake, a stunning 77-square-kilometer bowl of snow surrounded by 6000m peaks. This remarkable area has captivated explorers for centuries, with some, like Tillman, even reporting sightings of the mythical Yeti through footprints found near Snow Lake. This trek offers a unique blend of natural beauty and adventure, taking you through one of the most remote and awe-inspiring landscapes on Earth.

VISIT THREE BASE CAMPS OF NANGA PARBAT IN THE WESTERN HIMALAYAS

Nanga Parbat (8125m/26,813ft), the second highest mountain in Pakistan and the 9th in the world, is a colossal peak known as the "Naked Mountain" or the infamous "Killer Mountain" due to its early climbing tragedies. The mountain's challenging terrain claimed many lives before it was finally conquered by Hermann Buhl, who made a legendary solo ascent without oxygen. Our program offers a circular trek around Nanga Parbat, immersing you in the stunning landscapes and rich culture of the surrounding areas. The journey includes crossing the semi-technical Mazeno Pass (5399m), where fixed ropes are needed for a safe descent down its steep, crevassed slopes. This trek provides a unique and thrilling experience of one of the world's most formidable mountains.
