- Server-based license management continues to be employed, making it easier to support new and/or off-site User deployment while eliminating the need for Registration Number requests.
- Although the new version of the software will require installation locally, updates for the new version will continue to be automatically delivered right to your machine, helping keep all Users current and running the latest revision without the need for IT support.
- The mouse wheel operation in past versions was a little "lumpy"; it now works as expected in all cases and for all appropriate controls.
- GASWorkS provides a robust set of options and settings to allow the User to tailor the interface and its behavior to better meet their individual needs. In the past, these settings and options were accessed from various locations that were sometimes difficult to remember. Many options and settings have been grouped and combined into a single tabbed form. Consolidating them makes finding, setting, and applying a setting much more efficient.
- Use of the Color Legend could be a bit unruly in previous versions. The Color Legend is now incorporated into the GDI sidebar. This makes viewing and working with the Color Legend much easier.
- GASWorkS uses a "relational" style database method to store and manage its many data features. This method requires multiple files or tables to be effective. In past versions, these multiple files were stored individually, making moving or copying a model a bit cumbersome. A new file format, referred to as a "gwz", is now supported. This format stores all required files and tables in a single, easily managed .gwz file.
- The Solution Log provides various information about the solution process and lists exceptions or errors that may occur during the process. The new Solution Log allows the User to click on a reported error or exception and be "zoomed" to that location in the model. Making troubleshooting a misbehaving model a bit easier.
- · Various new commands and enhancements have been added to provide a better overall User interface and experience.
