## **Basic Post Deliverance Instructions for Maintaining Your Deliverance**

In order to maintain your deliverance, you will need to take responsibility for your home, and your relationship with God. Deliverance is the first battle and staying free from demonic influences is the second battle.

The first priority is your daily spiritual warfare prayers. Here is a shortlist of prayers that should be prayed every day for the rest of your life if you want to be a victorious Christian.

## Daily Spiritual warfare prayers:

- 1. Cover yourself with the blood of Jesus, over your mind, body, spirit, over your property possessions, cars finances, health, job, marriage, and relationships.
- 2. Forbid any transfer of spirits from anyone or anything to you. Also forbid any transfer of virus, disease, sickness, or infirmity to you and your family.
- 3. Put on the armor of God see *Ephesians 6:10-18*, pray this scripture, and personalize it to you.
- 4. Take spiritual authority over the geographical location of where you live and work.

Maintain your home by cleaning out all ungodliness, praying over it, and dedicating your home to the Lord for your protection. If you have defiling objects in your home it gives the devil the legal right to harass you and create spiritual activity in your home.

- 1. Remove all occult books and objects, ungodly rock music, souvenirs, and Jewelry that would give the devil the legal right to bother you. The rule is if Jesus visited you at home what would you be ashamed of if he saw it. Then it must go.
- 2. Pray over your home by anointing every window and door in every room of your house and pray over the rooms asking God to cleanse and sanctify the rooms while asking him to forgive any known or unknown sin that may have been committed in that room.
- 3. Walk the perimeter of your property line once, and claim the property for the lord dedicating it to him. Make sure in doing that, that you anoint your cars and pray over them as well.

Be aware of your activities and ungodly influences in your life.

- 1. Beware of taking into your mind and spirit ungodly television, movies, music, and the internet.
- 2. Keep away from ungodly and perverse family, friends, or relatives that will lead you down a path of destruction or sin. Especially with drugs and alcohol.

Stay plugged into the Lord, your Bible, and church by these activities.

- 1. Have a consistent daily prayer life.
- 2. Attend church as often as possible
- 3. Read and study the Bible. Get a Bible reading program. Many Bible apps have these. Memorize scriptures and quote them when temptation occurs.
- 4. Get baptized in the Holy Spirit with the evidence of speaking in tongues. If you're not baptized in the Holy Spirit then seek him for it.
- 5. Get plugged into a church by being fed weekly through services and Bible studies, also get involved in the ministries and activities of the church that are a good fit for you.
- 6. Have consistent fellowship with mature Christians who can help you to grow and influence you in a positive way.

Use your authority and weapons of warfare to combat Satan

- 1. Resist the devil by feeding the spirit man more than the flesh.
- 2. Make no provision for your flesh to engage in sin
- 3. Spend more time in prayer and fasting. Fasting can keep your flesh from temptation is a great tool in defeating the enemy
- 4. Bind the devil, his demons, and the strongman in you and those around you.
- 5. Take spiritual authority over the Geographical location where you live and work by binding principalities and powers.
- 6. Have faith in God and the operation of his word; meaning the promises He made to us all. Claim the promises by personalizing them for you.
