Insight: We must our own weaknesses and help each other to live the Christian life.
III. A CHANGING OF LIFE AND MINISTRY IS A THREAT TO CHRISTIAN UNITY. Vv. 35-38
1. The disciples were about to face a drastic in their mode of relating to Jesus.
2. Jesus called upon them to Him through the change and not give in to ungodly temptations to wrong actions.
Insight: We must trust in Christ no matter how our setting may be from what we have known in the past.
