July is always a very full month. As I write this week, we are nearing the end of our special Summer Fund Appeal on July 31. Because our 2019 giving has not kept up with our projected spending guidelines, we found ourselves about \$30,000 behind where we had hoped to be. Now, lest we panic too much, we also have not spent as much

as we projected either. We do our absolute best to be good stewards of the gifts with which you bless this ministry, and we thank you for your generous financial partnership. In this case, we were a little behind where we hoped to be by July, we made you aware of the situation, made an appeal for your help, and you have responded in ways that can only be described as sacrificial and humbling. It is obvious that you deeply care about Good Shepherd and our ministries bring value to your lives. There is no other explanation.

While we have not quite met our initial goal of 75 donors and \$30,000, we are incredibly close today, and I am fully confident that by the time I save this to my computer, we will have not only met, but exceeded our initial goals. A challenge grant of \$4,000 additional dollars will be added to the final total if we have 75 donors! If I was a betting man, I'd tell you to just go ahead and count on that. Good Shepherd ALWAYS responds, whether it be to financial needs or community needs, and that's one of the chief reasons I love being a part of this congregation.

July is also the month when I celebrate (actually, I usually forget to even mention that it's July 25<sup>th</sup>) the anniversary of my ordination into the ministry of word and sacrament of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America. The year 2019 marks my 20<sup>th</sup> year of ordained ministry, and I am deeply thankful to be passing that milestone as Senior Pastor of Good Shepherd Lutheran Church in Wausau, WI. It feels especially good this year. I've generally never been much for self-acknowledgement. It's not that I don't appreciate it. It's not that anniversaries, etc. shouldn't be noted and celebrated. Honestly, things like that just embarrass me. I don't even really like having folks sing "happy birthday" to me. So, generally my tendency is to downplay rather than announce when these events come around – so it can be a little difficult to celebrate, right? Yet, I really do appreciate it, and I know I shouldn't steal away opportunities to publicly give thanks for such special moments. I view what we do together as a partnership and a gift from God, and I only do what I do as an extension of the partnership in the Gospel that we share. So, in the truest sense, there would be no milestone were it not for the hundreds of folks with whom I have shared life in many and various ways over the last 20 years in Wisconsin at Bethel - Viroqua, Bethany - Esofea, Our Savior's – Oshkosh, and Good Shepherd - Wausau. So, I honor you as well on this celebratory occasion, and I am truly indebted to every single one of you for the privilege of walking even a few small steps together along the way.




