Good Shepherd Task Force Update...2-25-24

The Good Shepherd task force has been meeting frequently to establish routines and parameters for communication. Your feedback has been vital and is gratefully appreciated!

A few things of note...our first joint meeting with the St Stephen task force was held on Thursday 2-15. We talked about guidelines to allow us to share and question honestly, safely and respectfully. It was a productive meeting as we are learning a bit more about each other's culture, history, operations and aspirations. As shared in the Town Hall meeting on Sunday 2-18, two more congregations have suddenly voiced interest in joining our conversations. While we welcome their interest, it also makes these foundational discussions more challenging; hence, our synod will be stepping in to help us squash the rumors, establish clear channels for communication and authority and work to establish respectful dialog. As things have been changing at a breakneck speed, the synod also requested that the 4 congregations involved "take a sabbath", slow down and refrain from meeting together, instead, they encouraged each congregation to look inward to work to understand our motivations and vision.

The Good Shepherd team met on Monday 2-19 and will meet again on Thursday 3-7. The synod led meeting is scheduled for Saturday 3-16. In the meantime, we ask for your participation in completing the survey made available on Sunday 2-25 which is also included in this newsletter. These are tough questions...ones that we, as a congregation and a task force, are challenged to address. You will find a collection box in the narthex where you can put completed surveys as well as submit any questions, concerns, comments.

Finally, please keep the task forces, the councils and the congregations of Good Shepherd, St Stephen, and all our area congregations in your prayers as we continue to navigate uncharted waters.

Program Framework

Acceptance in the home is based upon a thorough Application and Interview process. We want to ensure that we are the best fit for each mother and her children. We will be a grace-filled home dedicated to strengthening families by offering an intentional time of growth. We will want to know that each mother is highly motivated to use her time at The Hagar House wisely and with a clear purpose.

Once we establish a mutual agreement of residency we will welcome the family into The Hagar House home. Our program will consist of 3 phases:

PHASE 1

Assess individual needs and establish clear goals with a case advocate.

PHASE 2

Actively working toward measurable goals, with regular meetings with case advocate.

PHASE 3

Complete goals and plan for moving into their own home. Celebrate their journey!

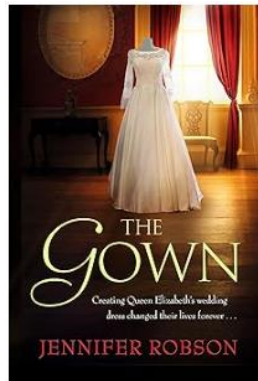
