## October Treasurer/Financial Report & 2026 Budget Conversation (approval)

Group reviewed financials - Contributions for October were \$15,153. Expenses for October were \$24,406, resulting in a loss of \$8,708 for the month after transfer of funds from Building Fund. NOTE that this was a three-payroll month which accounted for a good portion of the 'loss. Please see the Treasurer's report.

## Our Response to the Word

## **Standing Agenda Items**

<u>Kartika's Korner</u>: this Christmas season we will be using artificial greens for roping around the windows and wreaths in the sanctuary; currently gathering information on availability and cost. We intend to still bring in a fresh tree, though! "Sanctified Arts" program will be used again this year for Advent services.

## **Current Agenda Items**

- 1) Gratitude gift card plan for Custodial team (plan/schedule) our amazing cleaning crew indicated their desire to continue to offer their services at no cost to us; we would still like to show them our appreciation by way of offering gift cards on a somewhat regular basis. A question arose regarding potential taxation requirements [question posed to Treasurer]; will review in December to determine a January gifting plan.
- 2) What types of projects require Council awareness/approval? Josh, Marty and Laurie will do some investigation of this topic; note that by the end of calendar year 2026, our church constitution will need to be updated to match the national synod model. To meet the timeline needed for the approval process, realistically, we will need a draft document ready to send to the Synod by mid-summer.
- 3) Personnel committee recommendation for Bridge Pastor job description recommendations from Council were requested to a) update 'evaluation' section to include quarterly check-ins, rather than only at the end of the contract term; and b) ensure the 'temporary' nature of the position (not more than 24 months) is made clear in the

job description. Once the job description is updated, the Personnel team will send it to Laurie who will share it with potential candidates for a Bridge Pastor opportunity. Once the interested parties are identified, the Personnel team will establish an interview process.

- 4) Hospitality discussion on how to streamline a process for funding the hospitality hour; Marg shared an idea of how another church manages this type of process in a way that is simple, effective, and supports the community. Also discussed how to spread the workload a bit by creating 'teams' to work together. Marg and Lorraine agreed to lead a team to establish the funding process and to work on a way to expand the help!
- 5) Unhoused Population Outreach Laurie will take to the other local ELCA congregations' Presidents the concept of how to help community-level requests for funding rental assistance needs; the goal is to create a process to partner and approve funding requests for down-payment needs when unhoused community members find housing and cannot afford the downpayment. Will review this at a future time.

**Contributions**/income for October was \$15,153 which is 20.4% BELOW average giving for the month of \$19,036 and \$5,511 under the budgeted amount of \$20,665.

Contributions for 2025 are at \$224,621 compared to \$201,859 budgeted which is still \$22,762 ahead of budget. Giving for the year is still projecting around \$265,000 as December is always higher on average.

**Expenses** for the month are skewed because it was a three paycheck month and show \$3,248 over budget at \$24,406 actual. I plan on evening out the budgeted column for 2026 to account for changes like this so the monthly financials look better.

- Payroll With 3 paychecks in October, all of the actual amounts are up compared to budgeted which is fine, it just looks a little odd.
- Supply Pastor \$1,558 for the month compared to the usual \$1,000 budgeted. There were
  two funerals during the month where a pastor met with the families at an extra \$200 plus
  travel reimbursement for Nicole bumped it up a little bit too.
- Professional Services Down \$808 compared to budget which is good to see after the way the first part of the year went in this category.

For the month, ordinary income shows a loss of \$8,708 with giving being a couple thousand down and expenses being a couple thousand end with payroll. Building transfer was only \$544 this month as that's all that was left to transfer in that fund. Year to date net profit (ordinary income which doesn't account for building fund transfers) is at \$16,414 which is \$26,127 over of budget.

Current assets – One CD renewed and was rolled over but nothing was moved from money market for a new CD. We will do another one for \$15,000 this month.
