

Treasurer's Report June 2023 For Council Meeting July 11, 2023

June income was *\$54,622 (contribution income was \$17,942), expenses were \$19,065 for a balance of \$35,557 in total net income. Current reserves are \$62,850 in the general fund, \$17,012 in the building fund, and \$14,094 in work of the church.

*June income includes the Employer Retention Credits (\$34,437) and interest for Q2 2020 and Q3 2021 (\$2,243) received from the IRS.

Second quarter year to date totals (Jan – June): \$163,182 for income (\$126,502 without ECR and interest), and \$118,328 in expenses. Leaving us with a total net income of \$44,854 (\$8,174 without ECR and interest).

We budgeted \$130,000 in contributions for the first half of the year. We received \$124,050 in contributions, leaving a negative \$5,950 for income. We had \$118,329 in regular expenses and budgeted for \$123,316. Income vs. expenses for second quarter leaves us with positive \$4,987.

June Treasurer/Financial Report

- Cory presented June numbers including some extra income from Employer Retention Credits and interest from O2
 - We budgeted \$130,000 in contributions for the first half of the year. We received \$124,050 in contributions, leaving Good Shepherd \$5,950 below our budgeted income. We had \$118,329 in regular expenses and budgeted for \$123,316. Income vs. expenses for the 2nd quarter leaves us with a positive \$4,987. This excludes any government credits.
 - Tony asked how we present the financials to the congregation so that we can realistically report that GSLC is still ~\$2000 /mo. expenses over income. It was requested to include Cory's summary in the newsletter.

Ministry Site Profile (MSP) Survey Results Update

- Committee met to review survey results put together by Paul and Joann Grewe.
- Not many surprising comments and was what the committee expected
- Building a sense of community was a top answer for many respondents for a new pastor's responsibility
- o 85% of survey respondents have been attending GSLC for over 10 years
- The Committee feels they have all the information they need from the congregation at this time. There is more to complete if and when we decide we would call another Pastor.

Town Hall Meeting/Shared Ministry/President's Meeting Summaries

- Council members in attendance at the Town Hall meeting last Sunday stated it was the best, most informative, and direct meeting they had been a part of. Lots of good questions were asked and a lot of good feedback was given.
- A long discussion was had on shared ministry and why the Synod was not more heavily
 involved. The Synod is there for guidance and support of the churches, but they are not
 staffed or equipped to be there every step of the way for every church. Church leaders,
 along with the backing of their respective councils, are leading the way in this endeavor, and
- are relying on the Synod for support as needed. This not only lets the churches control their future but saves time and money by not having the Synod involved every step of the way.

 A meeting of Council Presidents of some area churches have begun meeting and getting to know each other, providing input on their respective church's situation, and provide feedback to each other. These are expected to continue, and input will be provided by Mike to the Council as needed.

Community Worship Discussion

- Ensured we're all set for setup, moving of stuff from GSLC
- Ride Share was discussed and announced but nothing ever came of it.

COVID Federal Government Check

- This money was given to GSLC for keeping their staff during the pandemic. Council
 discussed what to do with the money and it was recommended to leave in the General Fund
 in case a need arises
- An email was received with a suggestion to give employee bonuses to Angie and Kartika. It
 was discussed and mostly accepted by the council. It was thought that this bonus should be
 justified so it is understood by the congregation. Justification was discussed amongst council
 members and the Employee Retention Credit was received because we retained them both
 and they continued to work through the pandemic.
- Motion made by Cory to give both Kartika and Angie a bonus of \$1,000 for their continued great work throughout the pandemic. Seconded by Chad and passed by council.
