Our Response to the Word

<u>Budget Discussion:</u> Finance Committee is beginning to work on the 2025 budget. Recommend that they begin planning for our current status again for next year, knowing that a budget could be amended if our situation changes significantly before the end of 2025. At this time, Council does not support the pursuit of a Pastor (part-time or otherwise).

<u>Task Force Update</u>: Task Force met with Pilgrim Lutheran's Task Force on Monday, August 5 - honest, open, discussion was had about partnership and future of Wausau area ELCA congregations. The next meeting will likely include Pilgrim, St Stephen, and Good Shepherd teams. No concerns were raised about continuing forward together.

<u>Future Officers</u>: President and Vice President roles, by constitution, will come to an end in January (each can be in place for two years). Conversation was opened to begin thinking about how to handle this potential change in the midst of such change. There are a number of viable options to ensure we do not lose momentum and so much knowledge. More to come!

<u>Kartika's Korner</u>: 1) September 8 - God's Work, Our Hands will occur at the Marty Bus (downtown Wausau, serving the unhoused); needs list will be posted/shared. This is a multi-congregational event (SHARED MINISTRY in SERVICE!). Lunch will be served and various products will be distributed based on the needs of the Marty Bus organizers. 2) Worship Committee report: fall dates have been set (9/8 - Rally Sunday & Marty bus; 9/22 - pet blessing; 9/29 - quilt blessing and Women of Good Shepherd to offer a chicken dinner - YUM!). Planning has begun for a variety of shared worship experiences throughout the fall. 3) Copyright processes will need to be

explored and understood to ensure compliance with laws. 4) Shared lay leadership - we have been approached by another congregation who wants help to provide a healing service at their congregation. Several members of the Worship Committee agreed to assist for this one-time request. What an honor!

<u>Round Robin updates/thoughts:</u> [thoughts shared by those in attendance at Council meeting] amazing experiences to have such great attendance at each location; it felt like church 'used to feel'; love the sound of the full space and especially the music! Fun to meet 'old friends' in other places; made some 'new friends'.

<u>'50 Envelopes/50-50 Update'</u>: this is the 50-envelopes concept to support a local food-security related service agency in need. Still working on how to make this happen, as Laurie has not been receiving responses from the agencies she has been contacting.

HR Changes: tabled to September while additional information is gathered.
