

## ABOUT

The Joseph Project is a faith-based jobs initiative to connect people with jobs. Participants go through a weeklong life skills training program and then are offered a chance to interview with companies looking to hire. The project started as a constituent service through the office of U.S. Senator Ron Johnson. While traveling the state, the senator found that manufacturers' number one concern was not having enough workers. Yet when he visited central city neighborhoods, the problem was not enough jobs. Johnson staffers work with Pastor Jerome Smith of Greater Praise Church of God in Chirsit to identify people ready for a life change, based on their attitude and determination. Once a month, a new group of participants attends free weeklong sessions at the church. The classes, taught by volunteers, cover topics such as teamwork, time management, financial management, conflict resolution and spiritual fitness. Participants who stay with it through the week all get a job interview with employers who are looking to hire.

## TRANSPORTATION

Every participant is offered the opportunity to get to work via the Joseph Project shuttles. The vans run 24/7 to make sure all shifts are covered. Due to the project's success, several vans have been donated to the program. Participants are offered 30 days free transportation, and then each worker pays a nominal fee for their daily transportation to and from work.

### **Our Response to the Word**

Pastor Cath Mode (coach) meeting - feedback shared; Council members felt the meeting with Pastor Cath on May 28 went well; members appreciated Cath's background and knowledge in congregational transitions.

Future Projects - An idea from synod assembly: "50 envelopes" to encourage giving in support of our community needs, at various levels. Request of Council Members - come to the July meeting with ideas of how we can support the 'food insecurity' needs in our community, and we will select a program to support in July/August.

Fresh Expressions - A 'new form of church' focused on those who do not come into a church building, taking worship/ministry to them! Laurie S participated in a synod-sponsored webinar to learn more about this structured program. It would be a very large endeavor and the timing is not right for Good Shepherd. Laurie also shared that there is a smaller program that could be facilitated through adult education. She will explore more.

Noisy Offering - November & December still need to be assigned; Laurie will compile a list of the organizations we have supported in the recent past and we will add November and December at the July meeting.

Minutes Review process - not all Council members have been able to successfully participate in the minutesapproval process we have been using; to ensure that we can still approve meeting minutes for sharing in the next newsletter, we will move to an email approval process rather than the email 'voting' process that had been in place. ### GOOD SHEPHERD TASK FORCE UPDATE...MAY 13, 2024 \* MAY UPDATE accidently omitted from June newsletter

This spring, the Good Shepherd task force has been busy with a variety of meetings with various groups. On April 22, the council and task force met to discuss the hiring of Pastor Cath Mode as a transitions coach. She is trained and experienced in helping a congregation through the growing pains and challenges of combining energy, efforts and organizations. The Good Shepherd council passed a unanimous motion to approve her hiring. Pastor Cath will meet with the council and task force on May 28. We look forward to her insights, guidance and direction.

The Good Shepherd task force met on May 2; we briefly talked about the quilting groups from Good Shepherd and St Stephen meeting together on April 23; 4 of St Stephen's 6 quilters joined the Good Shepherd group and it was reported that everyone enjoyed sharing ideas and getting to know each other a bit better. This was the first event in our shared goal of building relationships with each other. We also discerned the top agenda topics for the combined Good Shepherd-St Stephen task force meeting on May 7.

The combined task forces met at Good Shepherd on May 7. As we get to know each other more and our comfort and trust in each other grows, we have been able to start to ask and answer some of the tough questions. (What are you seeking? Where are you in this journey?). We discussed the value and importance of the surveys we pass out from time to time. The responses help keep us " in the lane lines" as we move ahead. We thank God for His guidance as we work diligently to understand the unknown paths ahead of us. The combined groups will meet at St Stephen on June 3.

The task force will also be meeting with Pilgrim Lutheran on May 29. Laurie and Mike Sturzenegger's casual meeting with the Pilgrim congregation in April went well and they are now eager to learn more about Good Shepherd's journey. We ask God to guide and bless this gathering as we get to know another Wausau area ELCA congregation.

### GOOD SHEPHERD TASK FORCE UPDATE...JUNE 17, 2024 \* JUNE UPDATE

The task force, council and staff of Good Shepherd met with Pastor Cath Mode, our synod provided transitions coach, on May 28. This introductory meeting allowed us to understand the process of combining energies in new ways. She explained that there are three main steps in combining efforts: sharing ministry, sharing leadership and sharing governance. Shared ministry and leadership build relationships which are necessary for shared governance; all steps require time and those solid relationships in order to be successful. We were all pleased to recognize that Good Shepherd is doing a nice job of sharing ministry and leadership!

On May 29, we met with, for the first time, several members of the Pilgrim task force and discovered several areas of commonality and shared experience. We look forward to getting to know the Pilgrim congregation members better as we continue creating a relationship with them.

On June 6, the Good Shepherd task force met to try to prioritize the myriad of thoughts, meetings, events, agenda items, and discussions. We continue to gather amongst our own team as we try to sort out and plan for our near-term future efforts.

The Good Shepherd task force met at St Stephen's on June 17. We spoke about the value of relationship building; some of the needs in the Wausau area; the possibility of Pastor Cath working with St Stephen and a bit about the summer round robin worship events (4 weeks of rotating worship events at Good Shepherd, St Stephen, Pilgrim and Immanuel). As our discussions are starting to delve into the "tougher" issues, we ask once again for your prayers as we work to untangle and figure out the more challenging issues facing us and as we become better acquainted with the Pilgrim task force and congregation.

We will meet with St Stephen on June 25. We contacted Immanuel again to offer our story and share what we have learned and are looking forward to the summer round robin services as opportunities to worship together, united as members of the Wausau area ELCA.
