Good Shepherd Task Force Update...January 27, 2025

On January 19, the Good Shepherd task force, together with the church council, introduced a new structure for the monthly town hall meetings. We divided into 5 small groups, each of which included at least one task force and one council member as well as several members of the congregation. These smaller groups allowed for more intimate and "safe" spaces to ask questions and share thoughts and concerns. Each group reported a positive, successful and informative conversation together; we look forward to deepening our insights and our commitments to each other in future town hall chats!

On Saturday, January 25, the GPS task force (Good Shepherd, Pilgrim and St. Stephen) met for its first extended time period "work day". Pastor Karoline led us in an activity using building blocks to symbolically "build a church." Three groups comprised of members from each of the congregations "built" their church and shared why they included what they did. We saw and learned what we felt were the important elements of a "church" and even more, what was not included in our creations and why. We spent time putting together a list of ministries, activities, events, and projects and then seeing what things we all do, and which things lend themselves to collaboration. A potential congregational survey was discussed; more conversation around this is needed. (Because of the extreme cold and Pastor Karoline's recuperation from overseas travel, the January 21 GPS regular task force meeting was cancelled, hence, there is no press release to share from that gathering.)
