

## **August Treasurer/Financial Report**

Group reviewed financials - Contributions for August were \$26,009 (includes a \$10,000 undesignated gift). Expenses for August were \$19,948, resulting in a surplus of \$6,160 for the month after mortgage transfer. Please see the Treasurer's report.

The Finance Committee will meet for budgeting purposes on October 6; they anticipate presenting a 2026 budget at the October Council meeting.

From Current Agenda items: Finance Committee request relative to budgeting process - what projects or other larger expenditures are anticipated for 2026 that should be considered in the 2026 budget? Discussed: parking lot needs (rough estimate \$35,000); furnace needs (parts are still available for our model, so we are not in a state of worry at this time).

### **Standing Agenda Items**

#### Kartika's Korner:

1) In-Sanctuary children's area - sometimes called a Kids' 'Prayground' - information has been gathered for this type of space to be configured within the sanctuary to help engage children (and their parents/guardians) during worship experience. Studies have also shown that these types of experiential spaces, when children are exposed early, improves membership retention of these disciples in the future. Discussion included potential for distraction of adult attendees, clean-up and disinfection needs, and implementation/management details. Note that we have been gifted a good supply of children's toys and other items to create such a space from Immanuel Lutheran at their closure, so no purchase needs are anticipated. Council members requested time to evaluate the concept and to consider alternatives. Will address at October Council meeting.

## **Current Agenda Items**

60th Anniversary Celebration Recap - attendance at the service was noted at 147; feedback was requested by the planning team; the cake walk raised over \$175 for the Riverview partnership fund! The free-will offering for

- 1) The meal brought in over \$300. BINGO was extremely popular! Overall, the event went very well! HUGE THANK YOUs go to all of the many helping hands. God's Work was alive!! Note that some attendees reported that they came because of the outreach of door hangers, Facebook posts, signs at the roadway, etc. Good work, team!
- 2) Stewardship Planning Update Seven people met on 9/8/25 to begin discussing stewardship/forward planning; discussion included a year-round team with a stewardship focus (not focused strictly on finances) and the possibility of planning now for a focused effort in mid-winter/early spring; the idea of resurrecting a 'talent fair' was brought up (this would be a way to showcase many of the non-financial ways to serve in this place). Next meeting is on 9/23 at 6:30pm.
- 3) Social Concerns Updates
  - a) God's Work, Our Hands to be held on Sunday (9/14) at the Marty Bus in downtown Wausau we will be providing chairs/tables for use, Strummers will offer music, etc. Estimated 200 attendees; this is a collaborative effort with multiple congregations involved!
  - b) Fundraising effort to support people in the Middle East pottery bowls are to be made (in conjunction with a local pottery shop) and sold along with broth and bread. This would be a collaborative effort with several other congregations.
- 4) Sunday School Update off to a good start; have a team to provide leadership; 6 students have been registered so far (as of 9/7). Volunteers welcome and appreciated! Contact Jenny Samperisi or the church office if interested. Bible distribution has been scheduled for October 26. Consideration to resurrect Cradle Roll (a program where children are followed from baptism to Sunday School participation) more to come on this!
- 5) Pastoral Needs/Staffing Status Update discussion continues around finding ways to meet Pastoral care needs for our congregation; a sub-committee will be formed to further this conversation
- 6) Finance Committee Request see above under Financial Report

October - Thanksgiving meal provision (specific organization TBD)

<u>November</u>- Support for our Cleaning Team [**note swap** between October/November to allow for October collection to actually be used for Thanksgiving efforts]

Treasurer's Report August 2025 Council Meeting September 9, 2025

Contributions for August were \$26,009 which is \$9,971 or 61.8% ABOVE average giving for the month of \$16,138 and \$8,701 over the budget of \$17,408. Giving the last Sunday of August was \$12,837 which is more than normal.

Contributions for 2025 are at \$188,380 compared to \$164,110 budgeted which is still \$24,270 ahead of budget. Giving for the year before this month was projected to be around \$250,000 but with the larger donation at the end of the month I am now projecting around \$260,000 compared to the budgeted amount of \$250,000.

Expenses for the month are \$1,209 under budget at \$19,948.

- Professional Services Still a little higher for August as we had one final bill from Kerber Rose of \$675. Next month should start showing under budget finally.
- Grounds Maintenance & Building Maintenance zero for the month which is always nice to see

For the month, ordinary income shows a profit of \$6,160 thanks to the larger donation this month. Building transfer was only \$760 this month as that's all that was left to transfer in that fund. Year to date net profit (ordinary income which doesn't account for building fund transfers) is at \$25,505 which is \$30,652 ahead of budget.
