LAST WEEK IN REVIEW In the final edition of the "Battle of I-40" in 2023, the Winston-Salem Dash dropped its series on the road against the Greensboro Grasshoppers, 4-2. In the final game of the series on Sunday, the Dash were down to their final three outs trailing 2-1 before a ninth inning for the ages. After the first two runners reached in the frame, **Shawn Goosenberg** blasted his seventh homer on the year to right field giving Winston-Salem its first lead of the afternoon, 4-2. The Dash weren't done there though as **Jacob Burke** drove home a pair of runs on a triple to the base of the wall in left-center, building the lead to four, 6-2. Burke later scored on a single to make it 7-2 and the Dash took the final game of the series by that same score.

SCOUTING THE HOT RODS The Bowling Green Hot Rods come into this week's series against the Dash off a series victory at home over the Greenville Drive. After dropping the first game of the series, the Hot Rods rattled off four straight victories before falling in the series finale on Sunday. Bowling Green holds the second highest team average in the South Atlantic League at .258, while also clubbing the most homers (131), led by the Rays No. 2 prospect, **Carson Williams**, with 16. The Hot Rods hold a 4.23 team ERA, good for fifth in the league. Bowling Green has five of the Rays top 30 prospects according to MLB Pipeline, including **Williams** (No. 2), **Willy Vasquez** (No. 9), **Brock Jones** (No. 10), **JJ Goss** (No. 18) and **Dominic Keegan** (No. 23).

LAST TIME THESE TWO TEAMS MET The Dash and Hot Rods met back in Bowling Green in the first week of June. Winston-Salem dropped the series at Bowling Green Ballpark, 3-2-1, with the final game of the series being called after six innings due to rain resulting in a tie. Winston-Salem had taken the lead in the top of the seventh inning, but with Bowling Green being the home team, the bottom half of the seventh was not finished and after a rain delay of over an hour, the game was called reverting back to the score after the sixth. Winston-Salem went on to lose the first half of the South Atlantic League season by half a game to the Greenville Drive, the High-A Affiliate of the Boston Red Sox.

ON THE MOVE The Dash roster has seen a lot of turnover throughout the 2023 season. After departures from big names such as Jonathan Cannon, Tristan Stivors, Terrell Tatum, and Adisyn Coffey, Winston-Salem has seen new faces thrive in the Camel City. Jacob Burke and Tim Elko, who were added to the roster at the end of June, have become mainstays in the Dash lineup, while Eric Adler and Tyler Schweitzer have become big arms on the Winston-Salem pitching staff.

THE CAPTAIN'S CRUISING 1B Tim Elko has enjoyed his time in Winston-Salem since being called up from Single-A Kannapolis at the end of June. The Ole Miss product is hitting .323 over his first 25 games, with 5 homers and 23 RBI, while putting up a .615 SLG. Over his last ten games coming into Tuesday's game, the 10th round pick is hitting a team leading .351 (13-37), with two longballs and 8 RBI. "The Captain" last week in Greensboro was a force, going 12-26, with 3 2B, 2 HR, and 5 RBI.

SECOND HALF SHAPING UP The Dash find themselves in the second half of the South Atlantic League currently 8 games back of the Hickory Crawdads. After Greenville won the first half, the Drive are 5.5 games back but already have a playoff spot clinched. Even after Hickory's historic start to the back half of the season, Winston-Salem still finds itself in the hunt with series against every team in the division still to be played. Winston-Salem sees Bowling Green this week, while heading to Rome the following week before returning back to Truist Stadium to host the Greenville Drive.

MANAGERIAL MILESTONES April 13th's victory meant a little more to Dash skipper Guillermo Quiroz, who inked win no. 100 as a manager. This is the second managerial milestone that fans have seen in the last two years. In 2022, Truist Stadium played host to Lorenzo Bundy's 850th managerial win—an 8-7 Dash victory over the Bowling Green Hot Rods.

NEW SHERIFF (AND DEPUTIES) IN TOWN With the White Sox shipping Lorenzo Bundy, Danny Farquhar and Nicky Delmonico to Birmingham, the Dash welcome a new field staff for the 2023 season. Former Dash hitting coach Guillermo Quiroz will manage the team and is backed by pitching coach John Ely and hitting coach Jason Krizan. This squad stands out, as all three have experience playing at the major league level.

Guillermo Quiroz

Manager | Record: 143-200



Guillermo Quiroz returns to Winston-Salem now as the manager for the Dash following two seasons at the helm for the Kannapolis Cannon Ballers, the White Sox Low-A affiliate. Quiroz, a native of Venezuela, was drafted by the Toronto Blue Jays in 1998 and made his MLB debut six years later in 2004. Quiroz played 29 games at the Major League level for the Blue Jays over the next two seasons before going on to play for five more organizations between the minor and major league level. The catcher played for the Seattle Mariners, San Francisco Giants, Texas Rangers and Baltimore Orioles before he retired after the 2016 season. With this experience, Quiroz was hired as a coach for his first stint in Winston-Salem back in 2018 and then became a coach for the Charlotte Knights, the White Sox Triple A affiliate, in 2019. Hired as the manager in 2020 for the Cannon Ballers, his debut was delayed due to the COVID-19 outbreak.

John Ely

Pitching Coach



Former third round draft pick of the White Sox back in 2007, John Ely follows manager Guillermo Quiroz to Winston-Salem after spending the last two seasons as the pitching coach for the Kannapolis Cannon Ballers. Ely, a right-handed pitcher drafted out of Miami University (OH) spent nine years in professional baseball between the White Sox, Los Angeles Dodgers, Houston Astros, Boston Red Sox and Milwaukee Brewers organizations. The Harvey, Illinois native saw time in the Major Leagues from 2010-2012 with the Dodgers. Following his playing career, Ely moved to a coaching role within the White Sox farm system. He became the pitching coach for the Great Falls Voyagers in 2017, holding that position until 2019, where he made a brief stop in Winston-Salem in 2019. The former right-hander was scheduled to return to Great Falls in 2020 but was named Pitching Coach for Kannapolis when minor league play resumed in 2021.

Jason Krizan

Hitting Coach



Following an 11-year professional playing career, Jason Krizan gets his start coaching with the Dash this year as the team's Hitting Coach. Taken in the eighth round by the Detroit Tigers of the 2011 MLB Draft out of Dallas Baptist University, Krizan spent 11 years in professional baseball, including the Dominican Winter League. After his time with the Tigers, Krizan signed minor league contracts with the New York Mets in 2018 and the San Francisco Giants in 2020. In 2022x, Krizan made his MLB debut on April 29th and picked up his first major league hit.

Daniel Millwee

Assistant Coach



Daniel Millwee begins his first season coaching in the White Sox organization. Millwee calls Summerfield, NC his home and was drafted as a catcher by the White Sox in the 30th round of 2019 Draft. He spent a part of that same year with the rookie ball team in Arizona. Millwee played between Kannapolis and Winston-Salem in 2021 and only got 8 games in during 2022 before being sidelined by an injury. Before his time in professional baseball, Millwee caught for the High Point University Panthers in 2018 and 2019.

Athletic Trainer Carson Wooten returns for a third season with the Dash. Wooten hails from California and is a graduate of Boise State University. Before making his Dash debut in 2021, he spent time with the Boston Red Sox organization as well as the Great Falls Voyagers, former rookie affiliate of the Chicago White Sox.

A native of Zebulon, NC, Logan Jones joins the Dash as the Performance Coach for the 2023 season.
