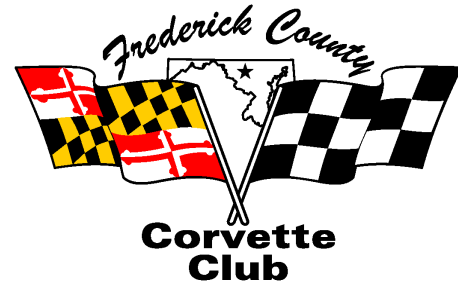


# FCCC Newsletter
