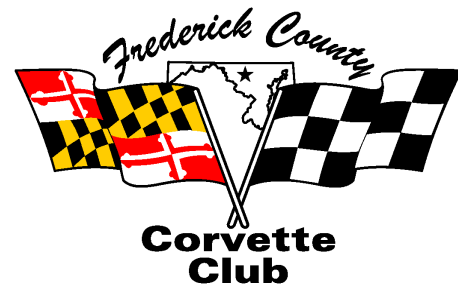


FCCC Newsletter

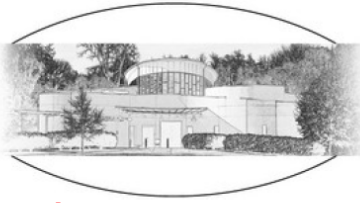

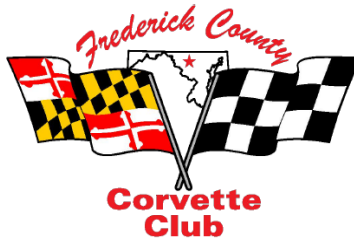
