Coaches Code of Conduct

It is expected that all coaches and assistants will complete a Coaches form, however this does not ensure you a position of coaching, league board and area commissioners determines coaching staff.

Be a role model: The coach and assistant should display behaviors they expect the players to display. Have a positive attitude; promote good sportsmanship, reinforcement of appropriate behavior, being team players, with all position as important as next. Will not at any time go against any of the leagues rules.

Be responsible: The coach and assistant need to have practice only when allowed by the AFL football rules and bylaws, notify players should there be a change in game times well in advance.

Be aware of the total benefits: The coach and assistant need to remember that taking part in an activity is a learning experience encompassing physical, mental, social, and emotional wellbeing.

Be aware of the perception of favorites: The coach and assistant should show respect for all players and be fair and consistent in the treatment of all players. They should be committed to the team as a whole. Every player regardless of skill should have equal playing time. Stress academics: The coach and assistant need to emphasize academic achievement and work with the player to promote success.

Support the co-curricular code of conduct: The coach or assistant needs to understand no matter what gender the player is, they deserve the respect of coaches and other players. Coaches and their assistants need to support the decisions of the league as a whole in order to maintain consistency throughout the league. It is also expected that all coaches will maintain to the best of their ability the leagues moral values and philosophy. (We are a fundamental youth league, learning basic football, playing as a team and having fun)

Coaches are not to argue with a referee, parent or board member during games, if an argument is to start by the coach that coach will be asked to leave the field, or the game will be called.

The League has right to refuse a person to coach due for various reasons, or dismiss a coach if league representatives, feel a coach is not following league rules; including practice schedule, or if a coaches conduct during practice and games becomes a repeated issue throughout season.
