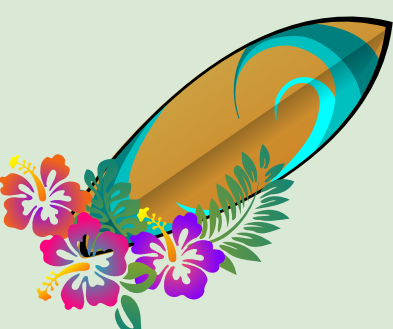


Hawaii (Hawaiian: Hawai'i) is a group of volcanic islands in the central Pacific Ocean. The islands lie 2,397 miles from San Francisco, California, to the east and 5,293 miles from Manila, in the Philippines, to the west.

The capital is Honolulu, located on the island of Oahu. In the 19th century, the Hawaiian Islands saw population expansion and the establishment of a plantation system for growing sugar cane, coffee and pineapples. The United States annexed the territory in 1898. On the morning of December 7, 1941, hundreds of Japanese fighter planes attacked the American naval base at Pearl Harbor near Honolulu, propelling the United States into World War II. Hawaii became the 50th U.S. state on August 21, 1959.

### What is a Luau?

In the Hawaiian language, the word "luau" translates to "young taro tops." This word was used in reference to a food dish, usually chicken or squid baked in coconut milk and taro. Luau is a traditional Hawaiian food which was served at an ahaaina, or feast. Around the 1850s, the word luau came to represent the feast where the food – taro tops – was served. Over time, and influenced by advertisers, the word began to represent a gathering meal of food, music, and dancing. You will have to wait and see what the Carrington Court menu is going to be for our Luau!!! Our Kitchen Manager, Dara, is a superb chef and will delight everyone with her culinary skills.
