KEY INITIATIVE

Prerana - Vocational & Life Skills Training

SEWAK has launched Prerana, a vocational training program designed to equip youth from marginalized communities with market-driven skills. This initiative focuses on providing job-oriented training for young men and women (18-25 years) in rural and urban Madhya Pradesh. Courses include:

- ★ Customer Relations & Sales (CRS) ★ Retail Management ★ Hospitality and Tourism
- ★ Solar PV Installer ★ IT-enabled Services

To enhance employability, the curriculum integrates English communication, basic computer education, personality development, and life skills training.

PROJECTS

NSDC-AMBER Project (National Skill Development Corporation - AMBER)

SEWAK has partnered with the NSDC-AMBER Project. This initiative under AMBER has allowed SEWAK to assess individuals with prior experience but lacking formal certification, offering them recognized credentials to enhance their employability.

Key Achievements:

- Conducted assessments for over 3,000 individuals in diverse sectors, including hospitality, and retail.
- Enabled job placements by linking candidates to industry partners who recognize these certifications.

PMKVY 4.0 (Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana)

SEWAK's involvement in PMKVY 4.0 has been one of the cornerstone projects, training over 11,000 unemployed youth in market-relevant skills and achieving impressive results in terms of both training and placements. The initiative aims to create a skilled workforce and enhance youth employability in various sectors.

Key Achievements:

- Trained over 11,000 youth in diverse job roles such as retail, healthcare, beauty, hospitality, and Telecom.
- Ensured a 100% placement rate in select districts, aligning training with industry demand and employer requirements.

DDUGKY-Sagarmala (Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Grameen Kaushalya Yojana - Sagarmala)

The DDUGKY-Sagarmala Project focuses on providing skill development to rural youth, particularly from coastal regions, to cater to the growing maritime and logistics sectors. SEWAK played a crucial role in training youth for port operations, logistics, and related industries.

Key Achievements:

- Trained rural youth from coastal areas in specialized skills for the maritime sector, including port management, shipping operations, and logistics.
- Facilitated job fairs and placement drives, resulting in over 70% of trained candidates securing employment in the maritime and logistics sectors.

WCD Bihar (Women and Child Development, Bihar)

SEWAK's collaboration with the Women and Child Development Department of Bihar focused on empowering women through skill development in trades such as tailoring, beauty and wellness, and hospitality. The program aimed to improve the socio-economic status of women and provide better livelihood opportunities.

Key Achievements:

- Successfully trained over 2,000 women, focusing on skill areas with high demand, such as tailoring, beauty, and hospitality.
- Helped 70% of trained women secure employment in the formal or informal sectors, with many starting their own businesses.
- Soft skills training, including communication, interpersonal skills, and entrepreneurship, empowered women to confidently participate in the workforce and entrepreneurship.

IT Bihar (Information Technology, Bihar)

The IT Bihar Project aimed to provide essential IT skills to unemployed youth across the state. SEWAK's contribution was significant in bridging the digital divide and providing youth with skills necessary for jobs in IT and tech sectors.

Key Achievements:

- Trained over 1,500 youth in basic and advanced IT skills, including computer literacy, web development, coding, and digital marketing.
- Partnered with local tech companies for internship and placement opportunities, helping candidates gain practical experience and improve employability.
- Offered specialized courses in cybersecurity and networking, resulting in placements with tech companies and IT service providers.

SANKALP (Skill Acquisition and Knowledge Awareness for Livelihood Promotion)

SEWAK's involvement in the SANKALP Project focused on enhancing the skills of marginalized youth, especially in rural and underdeveloped areas. The initiative aimed to improve the skill ecosystem and link it to the demands of the labor market, with a focus on sustainable livelihoods.
