Assembling panel lay-out was quite a project, as you can see from the picture below.







REX MAURER SPOKE AT MARCH MEETING



Member and Master Gardener Rex Maurer shared some gardening words of wisdom with his fellow members at the March meeting.

He recommended using raised beds, which he said could be made with 2x6 untreated lumber. Old grass could be covered with cardboard, before adding new soil or compost material.

Rex's preference of fertilizer application is a spray directly on the ground early in the morning or in the evening.

He also advises us to feed the birds. They are the gardener's friends and help by eating some of the pests.

He encouraged us to attend a series of Master Gardener Talks, held at the Children's Garden on Tuesdays in June, July and August. The Garden is conveniently located near the Allen County Museum and the Lima Public Library. The talks are from 12:15 to 12:45.

COME TO THE NEW PARK



Plant Diseases Discussed


Dr. Curtis Young, from Ohio State University Extension, gave an enlightening program on Plant Diseases at the May meeting of The Gardeners of Lima.
