
The 90-metre-high church tower on the market square is not only the emblem of Nördlingen, but can be seen from far and wide throughout the Ries.



Deutsches Eck

with Emperor's Monument

The Deutsches Eck (German Corner) rises strikingly into the waters and forms the confluence of the Moselle and Rhine. The statue of Kaiser Wilhelm rises imposingly here. At 37 metres high, it was one of the most imposing bronze statues in Germany

Majestic 18th-century palace compound known for its sprawling, neoclassical design & lavish gardens.

Stolzenfels Castle

Only a few kilometers from the city center of Koblenz rises in the district of the same name, high above the left bank of the Rhine, the 19th century Stolzenfels Castle.



Fortress Ehrenbreitstein

The large fortress situated on a hill overlooking the city of Koblenz and the confluence of the Rhine and Moselle rivers. It is one of the most impressive historic fortresses in Germany.


