Membership:

Individual\$100/year

Membership fees are based upon an individual membership fee of \$100 per year. This is per person and non-transferable to other members of your organization. Individual memberships will follow the enrolled person, not the organization.

Additional guests can attend meetings for a nominal fee of \$20 per meeting.

On occasion, there will be opportunities for special meetings with possible additional costs for all members and guests.

Yearly membership is from August through June.
