

2025 was an outstanding year in Orange Beach, filled with events that celebrated our community and its vibrant arts scene. We were proud to support and participate in experiences that showcased the creativity and spirit of our town.

- The year opened with the **Acoustic Arts Series** in January and February, featuring intimate performances by local musicians, complete with beer and wine bars hosted by the Friends. In March, the **Festival of Art** returned with an impressive collection of works from artists across the U.S., where we enjoyed volunteering and promoting the **Patron of the Arts** program.
- The Grand Event** followed, bringing residents and visitors together to support arts education and provide scholarships for Baldwin County seniors. During the summer, we also contributed funding for **children's art camps**, helping young artists explore their creativity in a fun and supportive environment. In August, we attended and supported the special **Wood & Ivory concert**, providing a **wine and beer donation bar** while enjoying an intimate evening of beautiful music with our community.
- In October, **Arts Afire** delighted families with a colorful, child-focused fall festival full of interactive activities and Halloween fun. The **Frank Brown International Songwriters' Festival** welcomed talented songwriters from around the country in November, and we were thankful to attend and host a wine and beer bar. **Best of the Vets** celebrated veteran artists, and we were grateful to help host their special reception.
- As the holidays approached, **Visions of Christmas** filled the Performing Arts Center with festive cheer and we were happy to contribute funds for the performers, and the year concluded with **Light Up The Arts**, a beloved signature event spreading light, creativity, and community spirit throughout Orange Beach.
