- Finally, Light Up The Arts concluded the year with a breathtaking showcase of light, art, and community spirit that left us all in awe. This is another signature event where we, along with the Coastal Arts Center staff provide Christmas hospitality and cheer to our community.

## MEMBERSHIP REPORT

During 2024, the Friends of Arts had a total of 22 new members join the organization. Of those, 4 joined as Life Members. There were 6 members who changed their status from Annual Members to Life Members. As of January 1st, the total membership stands at 118. The breakdown is:
