



POLITICAL SIGNS

Political Signs

Political campaign, candidate, or issue signs may not be placed on HOA common property.

“Issue” signs shall be defined as any issue included directly on a ballot requiring a vote to pass or fail. Issue signs are considered “political” signs under the Westwood Hills Amended Declaration of Restrictions, dated July 10, 2015, and are subject to the terms for political signs set out in that document and in this Rule.

In accordance with the requirements of K.S.A. 58-3820, the time period in which such signs may be displayed will be calculated as 45 days before the election date. Signs should be removed no later than two days after the election date. As required by this statute, this timeline supersedes any timelines set out in the governing documents of the HOA.
