The puppy is sold to the purchaser on the following conditions:

Breeder Obligations

- The breeder has followed good breeding practices and verifies that both the sire and dam are AKC registered Siberian Huskies. The breeder acknowledges the AKC National Club Guidelines and the Kennel Club health standards for the breed and certifies that the sire and dam are sound breeding stock.
- The puppies have been reared in a home environment, socialized since birth and have been wormed at 2,4,6 and 8 weeks of age. The puppy is a minimum of 8 weeks of age and has been weaned. The puppy will leave the breeder with its 8 week vaccination and an AKC registered microchip. The breeder will remain registered on the microchip for the lifetime of the pup and agrees to take back the pup if purchaser is temporarily or permanently unable to be relocated. After 30 of repossession of the pup, ownership will default back to the breeder.
- The puppy will be examined by a vet prior to release and will be accompanied by a certificate showing that the puppy is believed to be in good health. The purchaser is strongly advised to have the puppy checked by their own vet within three days of collecting the puppy. If the vet certifies that there is any problem which makes the puppy unfit for sale, provided the puppy is returned in the same condition as when it was sold, and within 72 hours, the breeder will take the puppy back and refund the full purchase price. The breeder will not pay expenses incurred in the return of a puppy nor accept any claim for distress caused by the return.
- The breeder has inquired of the purchaser his or her past experience with dogs and in particular with this specific breed and on the basis of the information received is willing to place a puppy with the purchaser. Every puppy is an individual and the breeder cannot be held responsible should conditions, genetic or otherwise, develop later in life.
- Each puppy will be pre registered with the AKC with a "limited" registration status. The limited registration restricts the puppy from being able to reproduce and this agreement binds the new owner to spay ör neuter the puppy before 2 years of age. The breeder will finalize the AKC registration and transfer upon receiving full Payment and a registration name for the puppy.



- The breeder will provide a facebook page for puppy owners to communicate with. This site will be open to all owners of puppies produced by this kennel. Breeder agrees to allow and encourage all puppy owners to contribute updates on their puppy, ask questions and seek advice. Breeder agrees to coordinate annual meetings for any litter member to attend.
- The breeder agrees to provide lifetime support for the puppy in terms of ensuring it has a happy life. Breeder agrees to provide purchasers with assistance addressing any training issues and will provide free vacation babysitting services once a year upon notice and availability.
- The breeder encourages the purchaser to involve the puppy in sled dog activities including bikoring, skijoring and sledding. The Breeder will provide free mentoring services to any new owner and will help both them and the dog get involved in the sport at two years of age if the breeder and pürchaser are able to cordinate times and locations.

Purchaser Obligations

- The purchaser will be responsible for vaccinating the puppy at 12 & 16 weeks and will limit the puppy's exposure to other dogs until the final vaccination. The puppy will then receive vaccinations on an annual basis.
- The purchaser acknowledges that the puppy will need a rabies shot at 16 weeks and a year later. The second rabies shot will need to be renewed every 3 years.
- The purchaser agrees to neuter or spay the puppy by two years of age. The purchaser acknowledges that the puppy is not to be used for reproduction unless the breeder gives permission.
- The purchaser agrees that the puppy will be registered for a dog license in the county they reside in and that this license will be maintained for the life of the dog.
- The purchaser acknowledges that they have done their research on the breed and feel that a Siberian Husky is a good fit for their lifestyle. The purchaser acknowledges that huskies require lots of attention and exercise and agrees to provide an environment with lots of both.



- The purchaser agrees that the dog will be kept in appropriate conditions for its welfare and health. It will be fed on a suitable diet for its age and condition and have appropriate exercise. It will receive all necessary veterinary care to maintain its physical good health. The dog will be kept under appropriate control and will not be neglected or maltreated in any way. The purchaser attests that he or she has not been banned from keeping a dog or any other animal by any legal court order.
- The purchaser agrees to maintain their current contact info with the microchip provider and keep the breeder's contact information listed on the microchip as a secondary contact for the life of the dog.
- If circumstances occur where it becomes necessary to re-home the dog outside of the immediate family, the breeder must first be notified. The Purchaser agrees to not surrender, abandon, rehome or sell the dog without giving the breeder an opportunity to take back ownership.
