Dear Healthcare Professional:

The Virginia Hospital & Healthcare Association (VHHA) shared services affiliate ("VHHA Services") selected Germ Pro Products, Inc. as a preferred partner in helping VHHA members prevent Healthcare-Acquired Infections (HAIs).

Germ Pro has developed a Persistent Action Plan (PAP) that compliments existing hand hygiene and environmental surface cleaning practices by adding a persistent hand lotion and persistent surface disinfectant, both with long-term killing power.
