

## Adaptive Flipper Control

Do I need a 2 Switch Button add on kit?

The Adaptive Flipper Control (AFC) was designed to be compatible with as many pinball machines as possible. This includes the standardization of the hand controller. Having a device that works on machines made in the 1950s and those made in the 2020's required some level of compromise. The following paragraph will help you figure out if your machine needs a 2 Switch Button Kit.

First remove the playfield glass and raise the playfield. You can prop it up or raise it to rest against the back box if your machine is capable of this. Look at the LEFT flipper button inside the cabinet. If there is only 1 switch controlled by that single button, then the LEFT side does not need the kit. Now look at the RIGHT flipper button inside the cabinet. If there is only 1 switch controlled by that single button, then the LEFT side does not need the kit.

You will need a 2 Switch Button add on kit for each button with more than one switch.
