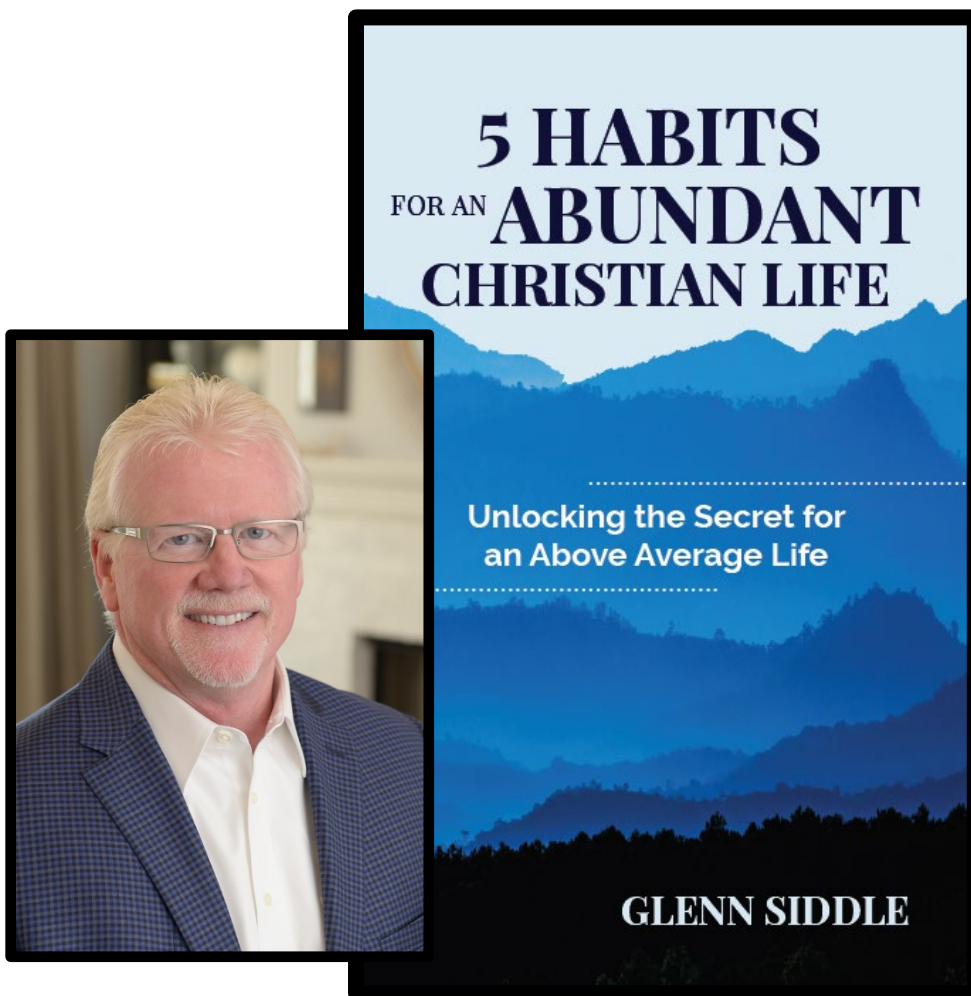

CONFESSION SCRIPTURES

FAITH

- Num. 11:23 Is the Lord's power limited? Now you shall see whether My word shall come true for you or not.
- Ps. 5:12 Thou dost surround the righteous man with favor as with a shield.
- Ps. 37:23 The steps of a man are established by the Lord; and He delights in his way.
- Ps. 84:11 No good thing does He withhold from those who walk uprightly.
- Prov. 3:5-6 Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and do not lean on your own understanding. In all your ways acknowledge Him, and He will make your paths straight.
- Is. 55:10-11 For as the rain and the snow come down from heaven, and do not return there without watering the earth, and making it bear and sprout, and furnishing seed to the sower and bread for the eater; so shall My word which goes forth from My mouth; it shall not return to Me empty, without accomplishing what I desire, and without succeeding in the matter for which I sent it.
- Hab. 2:4 For the righteous man shall live by his faith.
- Zech. 4:6 It is not by might, nor by power, but by His Spirit.
- Mat. 6:30 But if God so arrays the grass of the field, which is alive today and tomorrow is thrown into the furnace, will He not much more do so for you, O men of little faith?

And thus, having patiently waited, he obtained the promise... This hope we have as an anchor of the soul, a hope both sure and steadfast and one which enters within the veil.

- Heb. 11:1 Now faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen.
- Heb. 11:6 And without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of those who seek Him.
- Heb. 13:5-6 Let your character be free from the love of money, being content with what you have; for He Himself has said, "I WILL NEVER DESERT YOU, NOR WILL I EVER FORSAKE YOU," so that we confidently say, "THE LORD IS MY HELPER, I WILL NOT BE AFRAID. WHAT SHALL MAN DO TO ME?"
- James 2:18 But someone may well say, "You have faith, and I have works; show me your faith without the works, and I will show you my faith by my works."
- James 2:22 You see that faith was working with his works, and as a result of the works, faith was perfected.

ASKING

- Psalm 37:3-4 Trust in the Lord and do good; dwell in the land and cultivate faithfulness. Delight yourself in the Lord; and He will give you the desires of your heart.
- Psalm 91:14-15 Because I love God, He will deliver me; He will set me securely on high, because I know His name. When I call upon Him, He will answer me; He will be with me in trouble; He will rescue me, and honor me.
- Proverbs 18:21 Death and life are in the power of the tongue, and those who love it will eat its fruit.
- Daniel 10:12-13 Then he said to me, "Do not be afraid, Daniel, for from the first day that you set your heart on understanding this and on humbling yourself before your God, your words were heard, and I have come in response to your words. But the prince of the kingdom of Persia was withstanding me for 21 days; then behold, Michael, one of the chief princes, came to help me, for I have been left there with the kings of Persia.
- Matthew 6:33 But seek first His kingdom and His righteousness; and all these things shall be added to you.
- Matthew 7:7-11 Ask, and it shall be given to you; seek, and you shall find; knock, and it shall be opened to you. For everyone who asks receives, and he who seeks finds, and to him who knocks it shall be opened. Or what man is there among you, when his son shall ask him for a loaf, will give him a stone? Or if he shall ask for a fish, he will not give him a snake, will he? If you then, being evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more shall your Father who is in heaven give what is good to those who ask Him?
- Matthew 18:19 Again I say to you, that if two of you agree on earth about anything that they may ask, it shall be done for them by My Father who is in heaven. For where two or three have gathered together in My name, there I am in their midst.
- Matthew 21:21-22 Truly I say to you, if you have faith, and do not doubt, you shall not only do what was done to the fig tree, but even if you say to this mountain, 'Be taken up and cast into the sea,' it shall happen. And all things you ask in prayer, believing, you shall receive.
- Mark 9:23 All things are possible to him who believes.
- Mark 11:23-24 Truly I say to you, whoever says to this mountain, 'Be taken up and cast into the sea,' and does not doubt in his heart, but believes that what he says is going to happen, it shall be granted him. Therefore I say to you, all things for which you pray and ask, believe that you have received them, and they shall be granted you.
- Luke 11:8 I tell you, even though he will not get up and give him anything because he is his friend, yet because of his persistence he will get up and give him as much as he needs.
- Luke 18:7-8 ... now shall not God bring about justice for His elect, who cry to Him day and night, and will

	He delay long over them? I tell you that He will bring about justice for them speedily. However, when the Son of Man comes, will He find faith on the earth?
John 9:31	If anyone is God-fearing, and does His will, He hears him.
John 14:13-14	And whatever you ask in My name, that will I do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. If you ask anything in My name, I will do it.
John 15:7-8	If you abide in Me, and My words abide in you, ask whatever you wish, and it shall be done for you. By this is My Father glorified, that you bear much fruit, and so prove to be My disciples.
John 15:16	Jesus chose me, and appointed me, that I should go and bear fruit, and that my fruit should remain, that whatever I ask of the Father in Jesus' name, He will give to me.
John 16:23-24	Truly, truly, I say to you, if you shall ask the Father for anything, He will give it to you in My name. Until now you have asked for nothing in My name; ask, and you will receive, that your joy may be made full.
Romans 4:21	I am fully assured that what God has promised, He is able also to perform.
Romans 8:32	Since God did not spare His own Son, but delivered Him up for us all, how will He not also with Him freely give us all things?
Ephesians 3:20	Now to Him who is able to do exceeding abundantly beyond all that we ask or think, according to the power that works within us, to Him be the glory in the church and in Christ Jesus to all generations forever and ever.
Philippians 4:6-7	Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. And the peace of God, which surpasses all comprehension, shall guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.
Hebrews 4:16	Let us therefore draw near with confidence to the throne of grace, that we may receive mercy and may find grace to help in time of need.
James 4:2	You do not have because you do not ask. You ask and do not receive, because you ask with wrong motives, so that you may spend it on your pleasures.
1 John 5:14-15	And this is the confidence we have before Him, that, if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us. And if we know that He hears us in whatever we ask, we know that we have the requests which we have asked from Him.
